


2021 ÉLEVÉE VINEYARD PINOT NOIR



2021 VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season began with a winter ice storm, followed by rain at bloom and a heat dome in June. Overall yields were decreased due to the rain at bloom, but flavor intensity remained strong. A warm growing season kept berries small and concentrated. Much needed rains in early September extended the growing season, allowing the grapes a little extra hang time to build up flavor and balance acidity.

TASTING NOTES

The nose opens with earthy red fruits, dried herbs, and oak. A subtle cherry sweetness on the palate is balanced by savory notes, creating a lingering finish.
