









# COMPONENTS



Inspect packaging to ensure all parts are accounted for before disposing of packing materials.

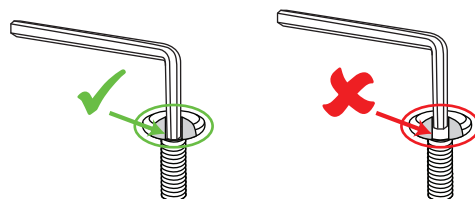

## ! WARNING !

**CHOKING HAZARD** — This item contains small parts that could be swallowed. Keep children away during assembly.

**Tip:** Always fully insert the hex key inside designated notch of the bolt.



If the hex key is not fully inside the notch, the hex key could slip out, causing damage to the bolt head. Repeated hex key slipping will cause the notch to become rounded, making it difficult or impossible to tighten the bolt with the hex key.

**ATTENTION!** Do not fully tighten any hardware until all components are loosely connected. If each bolt is fully tightened too soon, mounting holes may not align and parts may not easily fit together.

Turn each bolt, by hand, 2-3 times until the screw grips into the mounting hole. Continue this process until all bolts have been installed. Tighten all hardware.

Do not use any electronic tools to assemble these product. The high energy of electronic tools will cause hardware to over-tighten, stripping the bolt, bolt head, or bore holes.

Only tighten the hardware entirely after the product is completely set up.

Do not over-tighten screws or bolts.

# Care & Maintenance

*Resin wicker furniture requires minimum maintenance.  
Follow these basic tips to prolong the life of your resin wicker furniture.*

**Protect:** Storing cushions indoors when the furniture is not in use is highly recommended.

**Cover:** Covering the furniture with a breathable cover when it's not being used will help protect it from the harmful effects of sunlight, dust build-up, and collecting debris.

**Sun Exposure:** All materials and fabrics will eventually fade and degrade from sun exposure. Maintain cushion color and integrity by covering the furniture or storing cushions indoors when not in use.

**Winter Care & Storage:** Move the furniture to a cool, dry location to preserve the quality and to protect the frame from rusting. Covering furniture while in storage is recommended to help prevent dust build-up. Ensure cushions are stored in a location safe from critters and are completely dry before storing.

## Cleaning

*Regular cleaning keeps your resin wicker furniture looking stunning for many Sunnydaze to come!*

**Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials to clean the furniture.**

### Cushions/Pillows

- Brush or vacuum loose dirt from the cushions.
- Wipe the cushions down using a soft cloth and cool water. For more stubborn stains, clean with mild soap and cool water, using a soft-bristle brush.

### Furniture

- Remove all cushions.
- Brush, vacuum or use a garden hose to remove loose dirt and debris. If using a hose with a spray nozzle, use gentle or medium pressure settings; high-pressure sprayer settings will damage the construction of the furniture and void the product warranty.
- Mix 1/4 cup of soap or mild detergent with 1 gallon of warm water. Using a soft-bristle brush, gently scrub the dirt and grime from the resin wicker.
- Spray with the garden hose or use a bucket of water to rinse all traces of soap residue from the furniture.

### Wooden Surfaces

- Use a slightly damp cloth to wipe down wooden surfaces. Dry with a soft, lint-free cloth.



## SAFETY STATEMENTS & WARNINGS



- Do not exceed the weight capacity of the furniture.
- Do not sit, stand, or climb on the table.
- Inspect hardware often and tighten loose hardware before use.
- Do not put hot items on or near furniture.
- Keep furniture a safe distance from heat sources such as fire pits, patio heaters, and grills.
- Do not allow children to use this product without adult supervision.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials to clean the furniture.
