

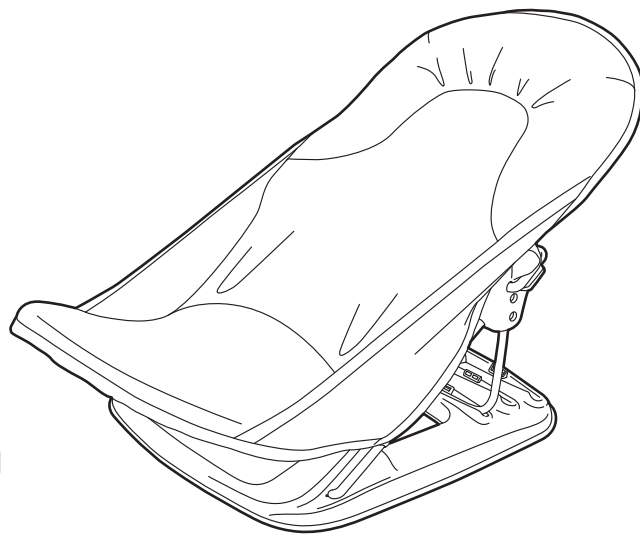


Deluxe Baby Bather

Instruction Manual

Please read the following instructions and warnings carefully and keep for future reference.

⚠ WARNING

DROWNING HAZARD: Babies have drowned while using infant bathers.

- **STAY** in arm's reach of your baby.
- Use **ONLY** in empty adult tub or sink.
- Keep drain open in adult tub or sink.
- Never rely on a toddler or preschooler to help your baby or alert you to trouble. Babies have drowned even with other children in or near bath tub.
- Infants can drown in as little as 1 in. (2.5 cm) of water. **ALWAYS** bathe your infant using as little water as necessary.

FALL HAZARD: Babies have suffered head injuries falling from infant bathers:

- Place bather **ONLY** in adult tub or in sink for safe use.
- **NEVER** lift or carry baby in the product.
- **STOP** using product when baby starts trying to sit up or has reached 20lbs (9.1kg), whichever comes first.
- **NEVER** bathe baby until you have tested the water temperature. **ALWAYS** check water temperature before placing child into product.
- Bath water should be between 90° F and 100° F (32.2° C and 37.8° C).
- Suitable for babies 0-6 months or until they are able to sit up unassisted.
- Make sure all the pieces are properly assembled before placing infant in product.
- **NEVER** adjust product with infant inside the product. Remove infant before moving or making adjustments.
- **NEVER** use on uneven or elevated surfaces.
- **NEVER** make adjustments or change recline position to product with child in bather. Remove child before adjusting or removing product.
- Discontinue use of product if damaged, broken or disassembled.
- This product is not a toy. **DO NOT** allow children to play with it.

cleaning & maintenance

- Remove fabric cover (and warming wings on certain models). Machine wash on delicate cycle with no bleach. Wipe frame with a damp cloth and mild soap.
- Put fabric cover and warming wings back on frame. Air dry.

Please check the following before each use:

- The seams in the fabric
- Ensure the frame backrest support leg is properly snapped into one of the slots on the base.
- Do not use the bather if any components are damaged.

bather setup

1 Unfold the backrest until it locks into the knuckles!

2 On the back of the bather, rotate the backrest support & lock into groove!

3 Rotate footrest down until it locks into place!

click! click!

click! click!

FINISHED!

folding the bather

1 Squeeze the footrest bars together & fold footrest up!

2 Pull the backrest bars out from the knuckles & fold the backrest over!

3 Unlock backrest support & rotate under!

squeeze! squeeze!

pull! pull!

FINISHED!

reclining the backrest

1 **2** **3**

Press the tab to unlock backrest support & lift out!

Reposition backrest support & lock into place!

removing the fabric

1 Squeeze the footrest bars together, then fold footrest up!

2 Pull the backrest bars out from the knuckles & fold the backrest over!

3 Slide the seat cover off of the backrest!

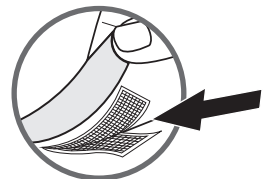
4 Press the tab to unlock backrest support & lift out

5 Release support legs from bather base by rotating the legs until key can slide out of slot!

6 Slide the fabric off the frame.

warming wings (only on certain models)

Attach wings by lining up hook and loop strips and applying pressure.



Wrap warming wings around child during bathtime.
