

2019 AGRINA VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

VINEYARD

Agrina Vineyard, located in the McMinnville sub-AVA, is one of the most distinct vineyards in our portfolio. The name, Agrina, loosely translates to ‘full of love’ – the winemaker’s love of the fruit, our vineyard manager’s love for the vines, and the love you will feel for this wine at first taste. Lynn and Ron Penner-Ash helped map out the southeast facing slope of the vineyard and assisted with the clonal selection. The site is planted to a variety of Dijon clones, Pommard, and Wädenswil. This diverse planting produces wines that are dark, dense, and texturally sweet.

2019 VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season started cool with small amounts of rain followed by warmer than average summer temperatures. As harvest approached, cooler fall temperatures allowed us to capture ripeness and flavor intensity in the grapes.

TASTING NOTES

Soft red raspberry and black tea mix with black pepper and tobacco, giving this wine a sweet and supple attack and bright acidity on the finish.
