PANORAMA VINEYARD

Our estate Panorama Vineyard sits in the heart of the Santa Lucia Highlands AVA in Monterey County. Daily wind and cooling fog, make this one of the coldest wine regions in California, leading to a long growing season and extended hang time for the grapes. This maritime climate combined with well-drained loam and alluvial gravel soils produces Pinot Noir grapes with concentrated, bright, vibrant fruit flavors.

KEY POINTS

Elevation: 400 - 600 feet

Soil: Well-drained Arroyo Seco gravelly loam, formed from granite and alluvial fan.

Climate: Cool climate with afternoon winds. Fog is usually thick in the evenings coming in daily from

Monterey Bay.

Profile: Black cherry and Bing cherry fruit with soft, velvety tannins. Integrated oak imparts a hint of

smoke on top of the fruit and earth tones in the nose.
