

Safety Information

For your safety, always remember to:

- $\hfill\Box$ Ground the fixture to avoid potential electric shock and to ensure reliable starting.
- $\hfill\Box$ Double-check all connections to be sure they are tight and correct.
- $\hfill\Box$ Wear rubber soled shoes and work on a sturdy wooden ladder.

IMPORTANT WIRING INFORMATION

Always follow the recommended wire strip lengths and wiring combinations when connecting wires.



Hold stripped ends next to each other and align frayed strands (do not twist wires).

Push wires firmly into wire nut. Using your fingers, twist wire nut clockwise until tight. Check for tightness by pulling wires.




Installation

1 Turning Off the Power

Turn off the power at the switch and fuse or circuit breaker box.

2 Removing the Mounting Plate

Remove the mounting plate (BB) from fixture (AA) by unscrewing the 2 mounting plate screws (DD) using a Phillips head screwdriver.




3 Installing the Mounting Plate to the Junction Box

Attach the mounting plate (BB) to the junction box by inserting the two junction box mounting screws (CC) through the slots in the mounting plate (BB).




NOTE: The mounting plate (BB) is directional, please make sure the arrow on the mounting plate (BB) points up to ensure proper installation.



4 Connecting the Wires

Use the wire connectors (EE) provided to connect the green wire from the fixture (AA) to the green or bare copper ground (house) wire. If the junction box is grounded, you may fasten the fixture ground wire directly to the junction box. Connect the white fixture wire(s) to the neutral supply wire. Connect the black fixture wire(s) to the power supply wire.




Installation (continued)

5 Installing the Fixture

Install the fixture (AA) onto the mounting plate (BB).




NOTE: The tabs on the fixture (AA) are angled to fit the mounting plate (BB). Please make sure to position the fixture (AA) at an upward angle to align these tabs properly during installation.




6 Securing the Fixture Insert and tighten the fixture

mounting screws (DD) through the fixture (AA) housing holes located at the bottom to secure the fixture (AA) in place.



7 Installing Light Bulbs (bulbs not included)

Screw in LED light bulbs into the fixture (AA) light sockets clockwise until they are secure (over tightening can damage both the fixture and light bulbs).



8 Turn the Power On

Turn on the power at the switch and fuse or circuit breaker box.

Operating the Fixture

1 Selecting Modes

- Flip the wall switch ON after installation to enter Mode 1 (light bulb only).
- Flip the wall switch OFF and back ON in less than 5 seconds to enter Mode 2 (light bulb + LED down light).
- Flip the wall switch OFF and back ON again in less than 5 seconds to enter Mode 3 (up light only).



NOTE: If the unit is turned off for more than 10 seconds, the mode will automatically revert to the default mode of Mode 1 (area light only).

2 Changing Color Settings

- While in Mode 2 (light bulb + LED down light), push the selector button on the fixture (AA) to select the desired color temperature.
- Continue to push the button to cycle through the available white colors.

SW = Soft White = 2700K

BW = Bright White = 3000K

NW = Neutral White = 3500K

CW = Cool White = 4000K

DL = Daylight = 5000K



NOTE: The downlight will remain the same color unless the selector button on the fixture (AA) is pushed to cycle through the different white colors.
