### ASSEMBLY&INSTALLATION

Please read carefully and save these instructions, as you may need them a later date.

### CAUTION

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.

# GENERAL


All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code(N.E.C) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustrations on the installation instructions.

# ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture, lay out all parts on a clean surface.
- 2. Attach the mounting plate (1) with box screw (3) to the outlet box (2).
- 3. Pull out the outlet wire and ground wire from the outlet box, make wire connections with wire nuts (10) as follow:
  - --Connect the smooth-coated wire (w marking) or Black wire (8) from fixture to the Black wire (5) from power source.
  - -- Connect the ribbed-coated wire (w/o marking) or White wire (9) from fixture to the White wire (6) from power source.
  - --Attach the fixture ground wire (7) to mounting plate (1) with the ground screw (16). Connect it to the house ground wire (4) with the wire nut (10).
- 4. Align the back plate (11) to the outlet box (2), then secure it to the mounting plate (1) with the mounting screws (12).
- 5. Set shade (14) onto candle leeve of the socket (13).
- 6. Install the bulbs (not included). Make sure they do not exceed the maximum wattage specified on the fixture's wattage rating label.
- 7. Turn on the power.
