Cut it Out

A good scrapbook starts with good pictures. Organize your photos according to themes like birthdays, holidays, friends and family. Highlight your subject by cutting away unnecessary background. This will make your photos more interesting - and take up less space.

You can also use your stencil to trim your photos or cut them into shapes. Place the desired stencil shape over your photograph, centering the image. Trace around the stencil, then cut around the outline.




Try this -instead of cutting your photos, consider printing them out on paper or making photo copies of your favorites.



Don't forget to save a special photograph for the cover of your scrapbook.

Mounting and Framing

Use the scrapbook paper to create interesting backgrounds and frames for your photos.



Lay it all Out

Think of your scrapbook page as a creative collage of your personal stuff. Use one or more photos, tickets, ribbons, magazine clippings, notes from a secret crush ...anything that helps tell your story.

Arrange your page by moving the items around until you achieve the look you want. Use your glue stick or stickers to hold everything in place and the title or letter stickers to call out the themes of your page!



What are you thinking?

Use your pen to jot down names, dates, locations and other important details. Write down the lyrics to a favorite poem, song, quote or just your own special thoughts.

Pretty penmanship can add personality to any page. Try this fancy lettering, or better yet, design your own artful alphabet.



Details, Details, Details....

Decorative elements can transform the ordinary into the extraordinary. Use your scrapbook paper to create almost anything....flowers, grass skirts, ocean waves, clothes, butterflies, bows, ice cream, pets. Just remember to keep your designs fairly flat so they won't squish too much when the scrapbook is closed.

Use the rhinestones to add a little bling to your pages!

Add a tiny treasure envelope to your page and then tuck in a locket of hair, ticket stub, note, secret message, lost tooth.... whatever!
