## **CAUTION**

WARNING: Risk of Fire. Consult a qualified electrician to ensure correct branch circuit conductor.

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture in order to prevent possible shock.


## **GENERAL**

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (N.E.C.) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustration.

## **ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION**

- 1. Attach mounting bracket (6) to outlet box(1) with box screws (9).
- 2. Thread two mounting screws (7) through the mounting bracket (6).
- 3. Pull out the outlet wire and ground wire from the outlet box, make wire connections with wire nut (5) as follow:
- --Connect the smooth-coated wire (marked) or Black wire from fixture to the Black wire (3) from power source.
- -- Connect the ribbed-coated wire (marked) or White wire from fixture to the White wire (2) from power source.
- --Attach the house ground wire to mounting bracket (6) with the ground screw (8). Connect it to the fixture ground wire (4) with the wire nut (5).
- 3. Attach the fixture backplate (10) to the outlet box (1) through mounting screws(7), secure it with the rubber (12) and ball nuts (11).
- 4. To prevent moisture from entering the outlet box and the fixtures mounting plate causing a short, apply a bead of clear caulk to outline the outside of the fixtures mounting plate where it meets the wall. Leave a small space at the bottom to allow any condensation or moisture to escape.
- 5. Turn on the power.
