

Note: This mixer fits a maximum bench thickness of 2 1/4" and has a 90° spoutarc.

- 1. Flush pipe work to ensure it is free from debris.
- 2. Cut a mounting hole 1 3/8" diameter in the desired position for the faucet ensuring there is 30 inches of clear vertical space below the hole for free movement of the hose. Check if there is 5[8" of flat surface around the edge of the hole, and that the handset is able to reach where required.
- 3. Remove faucet from packaging. Remove the mounting nut, horseshoe washer, horseshoe gasket, and the hose mounting adaptor. Make sure bench seal is in place and lower
- the faucet into place.

<u>Note:</u> retain the green/blue fiber washer in the nipple adaptor for installation. It is a special size.


- 4. Install the mounting nut, horseshoe washer and horseshoe gasket. Tighten the assembly with the lever on the deck on the right side. Please note: The range of motion of the lever only allows for installation on the right side when facing the faucet.
- 5. Insert the hose and hand spray. Check the position of the horseshoe washer. If there is any resistance on the hose through the deck; adjust as needed.
 - Check that the hose and handspray connection are hand tight, with a ¼" washer to make a sear.
- 6. Connect the nipple adaptor along with the check valve adaptor to the bottom of the nipple mount. The blue/green fiber washer is needed to make a seal.
- 7. Install the hose by holding the hose in place, and rotating the threaded hose into the Check Valve Hose Adaptor housing. A 13mm wrench may be needed. Note: A flat washer is needed to make a water tight seal.
- 8. Fit the hand spray counter weight assembly onto vertical hose position directly below the faucet. Take care to not twist the hose; position the two (2) weights, 14 inches from the top of the hose. Check the travel of the hand set and adjust as needed.
- 9. Tum on water supply and check for leaks. Test operation of handset by pressing button on side of handset to change from standard spray to shower spray settings by pressing the button on wand.

ADJUSTMENTS

ANTI–SCALD RING: An anti–scald ring is fitted to this faucet to limit the maximum movement of the handle when turned to the "HOT" position.

Ex factory the cartridge is set to the maximum HOT waterflow

- 1. Remove handle by loosening the 2mm set screw through access hole under handle hub with Hexagon key provided. Unfasten the handle from hub; then remove the shroud turning counter clockwise to access up to the cartridge nut.
- 2. Lift the red anti–scald ring sufficiently to disengage. Turn counter–clockwise and replace until the desired maximum temperature is obtained. Each notch on the ring gives a temperature change of approximately 3.5°F.
- 3. Replace components in reverse order.

Proof of purchase (original sales receipt) from the original consumer purchaser must be made available to **ROHL LLC** for all warranty claims. The warranty Is not transferable and is extended solely to the original purchaser of the product.

WARRANTY EXCLUSION

This warranty is for normal domestic use only and excludes defect or injury caused by or resulting from misuse, abuse or neglect, accidental damage or improper installation. The lifetime limited warranty does not apply to replacement of components where damage is caused by normal wear and tear.

* As a special note, avoid all cleaning products that contain ammonia, bleach, and alcohol. They may damage the finish.

WARRANTY WILL BE INVALID IF:

- A. The product has not been correctly installed (whether by a plumber, contractor, service provider or member of the purchaser's household) in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- B. The surface finish of the product has been damaged by use of unsuitable cleaning agents or improper matertals, i.e. damage by agents containing acidic, corrosive, abrasive or alcohol-based substances or through scouring the surface by abrasive cloths.
- C. Damage has occurred to component parts due to foreign materials in the water supply (e.g. stones, metal shavings). All water lines must be flushed clear of all debris prior to installing the product. It is strongly recommended that in areas where foreign materials may be present in the water supply, an in-line filter be fitted on both the Hot and Cold inlets. This will ensure your warranty remains valid.
- D. The product has been exposed to excessive high water temperature and/or pressure (above 80° Celsius or 175° Fahrenheit; ≥ 70PSI).
