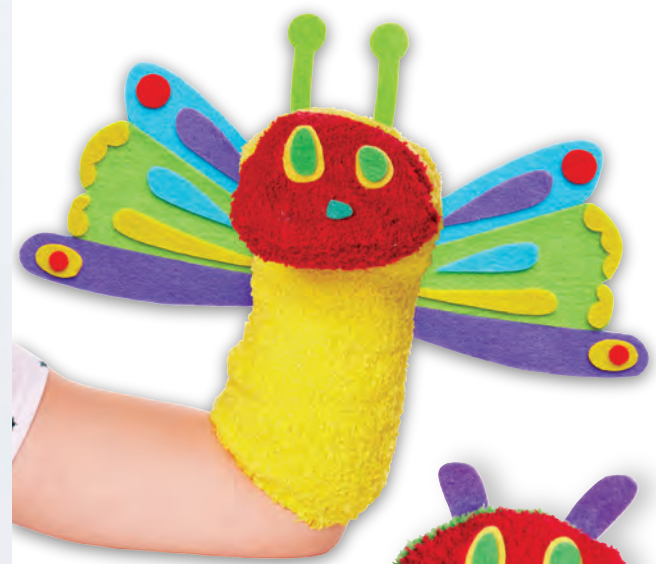




Story Puppets

GETTING STARTED

Start with clean hands and a clean work surface.



DECORATE

Smooth out your socks. Carefully peel and place the felt shapes onto the socks as shown. Work carefully, once they are in place, they will be difficult to remove and reposition. To decorate the faces, fold over the red portion of the sock.

CATERPILLAR

Add antennae and nose



FINGER PUPPETS

Insert your fingers into the foam finger puppets. To make them move, just wiggle your fingers.



TRY THIS! Chose someone to be the narrator. Divide up the sock and finger puppets between your friends and family members. As the book is read, each person can use their puppets to act out the story. You can also use the puppets to tell your own version of *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*.

CLEANING

Spot clean your puppets with a damp cloth as needed. Machine washing is not recommended. To reattach any felt pieces, use a small amount of craft glue. Allow the glue to fully dry before using.
