
IMPORTANT

- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the bolts until each part is properly assembled.
- Keep Ratchet Wrench as the bolts may need to be tightened in the future.

STEP 1

Attach Base Frame (B) to Back (A) with Bolts (1) and Flat Washers (2) tightening Bolts (1) by using Ratchet Wrench.

Note: Ratchet Wrench button is in tighten position. (See Figures 1 and 2)









STEP 2

Attach Left Arm (C) to unit by inserting hook in Left Arm (C) into hole in Back (A). (See Figure 3) Insert Bolts (1) and Flat Washers (2) into pre-drilled holes, then tighten.

Note: Please Pull the Tabs out before attach the Left Arm (C).





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


STEP 3

Attach Right Arm (D) to unit by inserting hook in Back (A) into hole in Right Arm (D).

Insert Bolts (1) and Flat Washers (2) into pre-drilled holes, then tighten.

Note: Please Pull the Tabs out before attach the Right Arm (D).







STEP 4


Turn unit to its upright position.

Place Seat Cushion (E) and Back Cushion (F) into position.



STEP 5

Place Pouch (G) over left or right arm by attaching Tabs on Pouch (G) to Tabs on Base Frame (B). (See Figure 4)





CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning and maintenance:

- Regular cleaning: clean the furniture regularly with a damp cloth or sponge to remove dirt, dust and other deposits.
- Deeper cleaning: use mild soapy water or a fabric-friendly cleaner for the removable cushions. Avoid harsh chemicals that might harm the metal or synthetic wicker.
- Wipe dry if exposed to chlorine.
- Spot test to ensure the cleaning agents do not cause any damage to the product.
- Avoid sharp tools. Do not use hard brushes or sharp tools in order to prevent scratches or holes in the fabric.
- Cushion care: remove or cover the cushions during heavy rain or when not in use to prevent them from getting soaked.

Storage:

- To prolong the life of your outdoor furniture, we recommend using furniture covers when not in use.
- During winter and inclement weather, store furniture indoors if possible, otherwise cover the furniture when not in use.

Usage:

- Use furniture on a solid and level surface to minimize prolonged exposure to uneven or damp ground.
- Periodically check for any loose bolts and tighten as needed.

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
