

2022 ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

The fruit was sourced from two Pinot Noir clones from the Gran Moraine Vineyard, farmed specifically for Rosé. A portion of our Rosé is sent direct to press, while the balance is destemmed and passed through our sorting line. Picking is conducted across two to three cycles to balance freshness and fruit flavors. No malolactic fermentation, and partial barrel treatment result in an inviting nose of floral and fruit notes, and crisp acidity complemented by a signature Penner-Ash mid-palate weight.

2022 VINTAGE

The 2022 growing season started off with an unexpected frost, followed by warmer than average summer temperatures. As September passed with sunny skies and warm days, we were fortunate to capture ripeness and flavor intensity of the grapes as harvest approached. The vines had plenty of water and a beautiful canopy providing us with a bountiful harvest.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of citrus, orange blossom, and fresh summer strawberries waft from the glass. Candied ginger and sweet tangerine fill the palate with sweetness, leading to a clean, crisp finish.
