


## Steps to Install

- 1. Before installation, carefully unpack and identify all parts.
- Place chair back (A) on a flat surface. Using a 1-3/4 inch bolt (G), lock washer (J), flat washer (K), and Allen wrench (M), secure back center of seat pad onto chair back (A). Do not tighten bolts.
- Using a 3-1/4 inch bolt (I), lock washer (J), flat washer (K), and Allen wrench (M), securely fasten back corners of seat pad (B) to chair back (A). Do not tighten bolts.










- 4. Place chair assembly upside down on a table.
- Insert 2 side stretchers L & R (C) into back leg holes. Make sure left (L) and right (R) sticker matches sticker on seat pad (B) before attaching 2 front legs (E).
- Insert front stretcher (D) between 2 front legs (E). Make sure 2 front legs (E) stickers match stickers on seat pad (B) frame before securing 2 front legs (E).
- 7. When all stretchers are in place and all legs are properly leveled, secure  ${\bf seat}$ pad (B) using 2-1/4 inch bolts (H), lock washers (J), and flat washers (K) with Allen wrench (M). Do not tighten bolts.



Using a Phillips head screwdriver, fasten side stretchers L & R (C) and front legs (E) with 1-3/4 inch screws (G). Do not over-tighten.



Place the chair right side up on an even surface and tighten all bolts when all legs are properly leveled.
