SETUP

- 1. Slide the bracket (22) over the top arm of the base (27), aligning the hole in the front of the bracket with the hole in the front base (27).
- 2. Insert base screw (25) through nut base (23) and into the hole on the front of coupling bracket (22). Tighten loosely.
- 3. Insert handle (16) into coupling bracket (22) and align the 2 holes in each.
- 4. Insert the wing nuts (26) through the bottom of the holes in the Base (27) and place light bracket (21) on top. Tighten with M6 nuts (20).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before first use be sure the work light is fully charged. Using the included USB cable, find a standard USB outlet and plug the cord in to the micro USB port in the back of the work and then into the USB outlet. A red LED indicator light signals unit is charging. A green indicates light means the unit is fully charged and ready to use.

- 1. Follow charging instructions above
- 2. To turn on, push the power switch on the back of the light.
- 3. To turn off, push the power switch again.
- 4. To prevent accidents turn light off when finished, do not leave plugged in, and do not operate while plugged in. Clean, then store the light indoors out of children's reach.


