
If any hinge requires slight adjustment out, loosen Bolt II and adjust out as necessary.


To adjust the Left Hand Doors: Adjust door to Right by turning Bolt III clockwise. Adjust door to Left by turning Bolt III counterclockwise.


To adjust the Right Hand Doors: Adjust door to Left by turning screw III clockwise. Adjust door to Right by turning screw III counterclockwise.

Once all adjustments are made and doors are aligned, install set screw D in the last 2 holes in the mounting plate, on 2 doors, 8 places.











.For best results, we suggest securing your Vanity to a stud in at least two locations.


- . Mark the location of the Studs in the wall on the stretcher rail.
- . Drill a 1/16" thru hole in the center of the Stretcher Rail at the location of the studs in the wall.
- . Secure the Vanity to the wall using screws (J) make sure the screws align with the Stud in the wall.
- . If hole locations do not align with stud in wall, install the EZ Anchor(K) in to drywall and then screwing the EZ Anchor in to the drywall.
