2019 VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season started cool with small amounts of rain followed by warmer than average summer temperatures. As harvest approached, cooler fall temperatures allowed us to capture ripeness and flavor intensity in the grapes.

TASTING NOTES

Jasmine and sweet delicate oak waft from the glass. A subtle sweetness on the entry is balanced with a soft touch of acidity. The palate provides weight mixed with vanilla and fresh hints of white flowers creating a wine with airy elegance.
