

3M Floor Stripper

Description

3M™ Floor Stripper is designed to remove floor finishes and sealers from hard floors easily and completely, including finishes hardened by frequent burnishing. It aggressively attacks heavily built-up finish and has an easy rinsing formula. It provides fast, thorough and uniform stripping results.

Special Features

- Aggressively removes finishes and sealers; including finishes hardened by frequent burnishing, excess finish build-up and tough metal interlock finishes.
- Easy rinsing formula.
- Non-ammoniated formula is comfortable to work with, even in confined areas.
- Provides fast, thorough and uniform results.
- Low foaming formula.

Where and When to Use

- Use to remove all water-based floor finishes and sealers; prior to the application of floor finish or sealer.
- Not for use on wood floors.

Packaging

- 2-1/2 gal. plastic containers — 2 per case.
- 55 gal. steel drums.

Directions for Use

Dilution of Concentrate:

Mix 1 part concentrate with 4 parts warm water (32 ounces per gallon of water) to remove most finishes and sealers.

Mix 1 part concentrate with 2 parts of warm water (64 ounces per gallon of water) to remove heavy build-up or finish hardened by frequent burnishing.

Use Instructions:

1. Sweep or dust mop the floor.
2. Liberally apply solution to the floor with a mop, leaving the floor uniformly wet.

Note: Wet floor may be slippery.

3. Allow solution to soak in for five minutes. Do not let solution dry.
4. Use a floor machine and an appropriate 3M stripping pad to thoroughly strip the floor.

Note: To remove heavy build-up especially along baseboards, apply 3M brand Trouble Shooter Cleaner and scrub using a 3M brand Doodlebug Pad Holder fitted with a 3M brand Doodlebug Pad.

5. Pick up dissolved finish, soil and stripper with a clean mop or wet vacuum.
6. Rinse the floor twice with clean water and clean mop, removing all remaining finish, soil and stripper.
7. Let the floor dry completely before applying finish.

Note: This product can be scrubbed and picked up using an automatic scrubber equipped with an appropriate 3M stripping pad. Allow the solution to soak in for five minutes before agitation and pick up.

8. Dust mop the floor with 3M brand Doodleduster cloth to pick up fine lint and hair left behind in the mopping process.
