## Rosé of Pinot Noir

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Our 2023 Rosé of Pinot Noir zips with citrus up front and follows with a texturally opulent middle, finishing with long seamless mouthwatering acidity.

The 2023 Growing Season began cool and dry. Spring was one of the wettest and coldest on record leading to late bud break.

May was warm and dry causing explosive vine growth. Flowering occurred in mid-June with ideal growing conditions throughout summer, with the exception of one heat spike during August. The fruit came in beautifully and the wines are forward and fresh

#### OUR VINEYARD

Nestled in the eastern foothills of Oregon's Coastal Range, on the wild western edge of the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, the range's peaks to the west and south buffer maritime winds and rain from the Pacific Ocean, creating a more temperate growing season distinct from neighboring vineyard sites. Planted in 2005-2006 to Pinot Noir and Chardonnay Dijon clones, the 194-acre vineyard perches in thin marine sedimentary soils, and diversity of block exposures and elevation offer a diverse palette for our farming and winemaking team.
