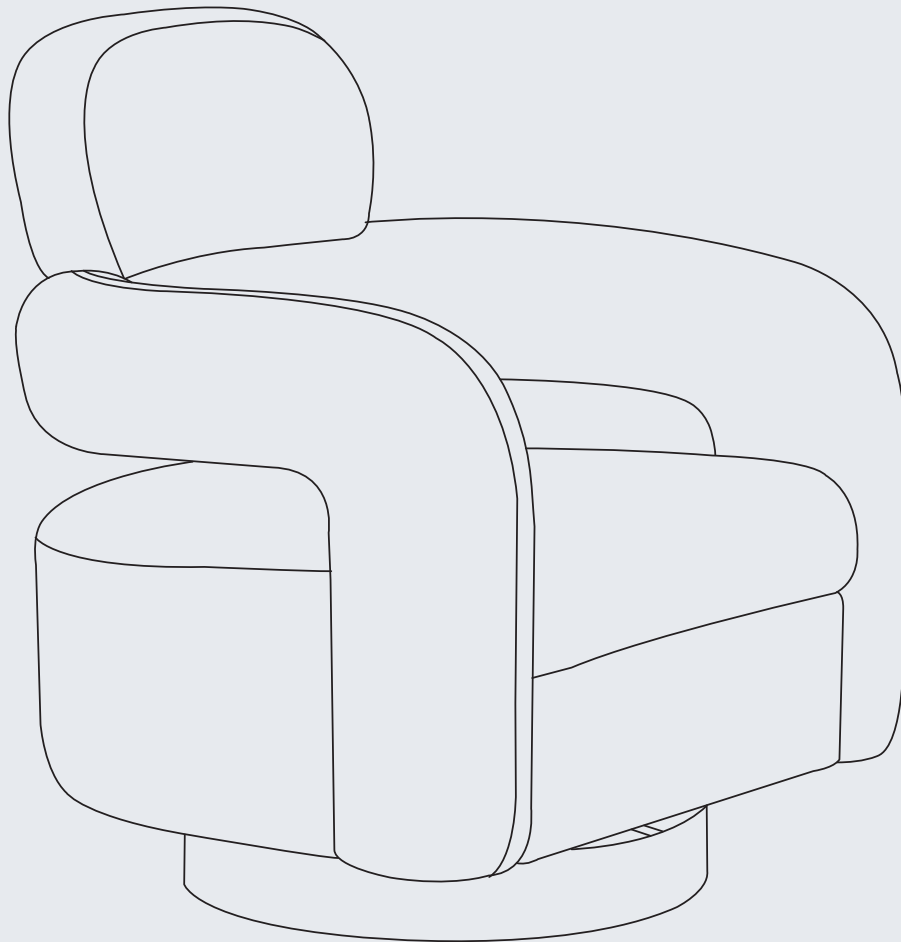

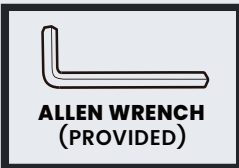

## ! CARE & MAINTENANCE

### Please keep this instruction for your future reference.

- Be careful when assembly, avoid hurting the top surface.
- Clean the table with lukewarm water, mild detergent & soft cloth.
- Firmly secure all bolts before use, do not use any part of this item as a step ladder.
- Reconfirm that all bolts, screws, and nuts are secure every 90 days.
- Do not use or store this item in the proximity of open flame or flammable/combustible chemicals.
- Be aware that some parts are heavy and have sharp edges.
- Do not overtighten screws. (Insert all screws before tighten screws.)

Look at the overall view of this chair and learn the exact position of each part to be assembled.

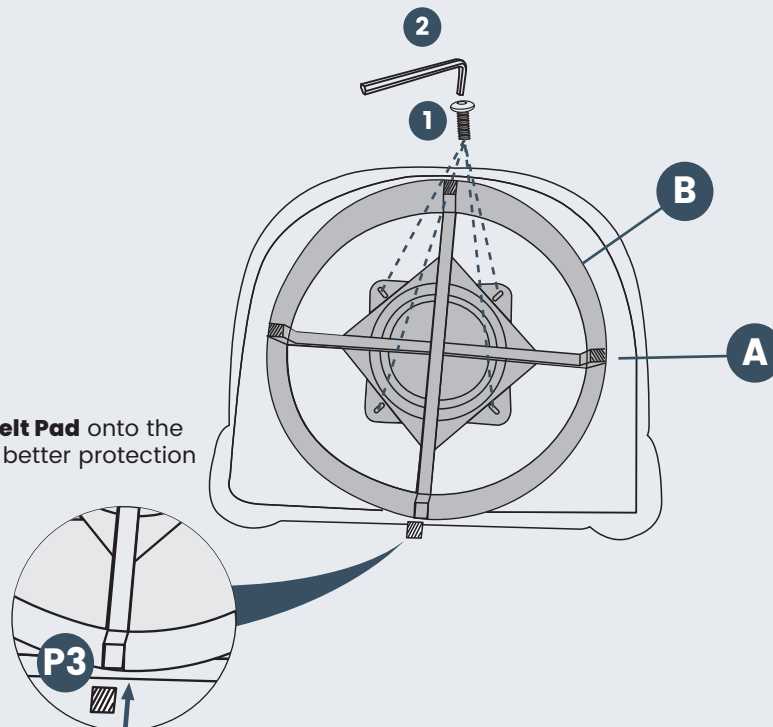


## PRODUCT ASSEMBLY

**1**

Place **Part A Chair Body** upside down on flat floor. Attach **Part B Base** to the **Part A Chair Body** with 4 pcs of **Hardware #1 Bolt**, through 4 holes on the **Part B2 Swivel Plate**.

Stick 4 pcs of **P3 Felt Pad** onto the bottom of feet for better protection of the floor.

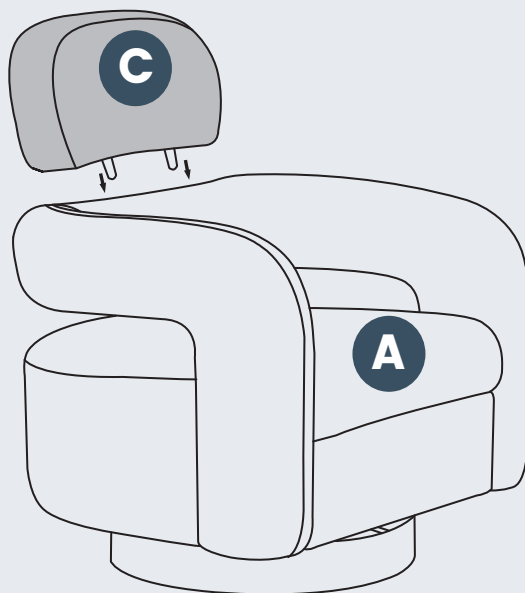

## PRODUCT ASSEMBLY

**2**

Place the chair upside on the floor.  
Insert the metal connector of **Part C Backrest** vertically into **Part A Chair Body**  
as shown below.  
Make sure both two metal connectors are pushed into the very bottom.

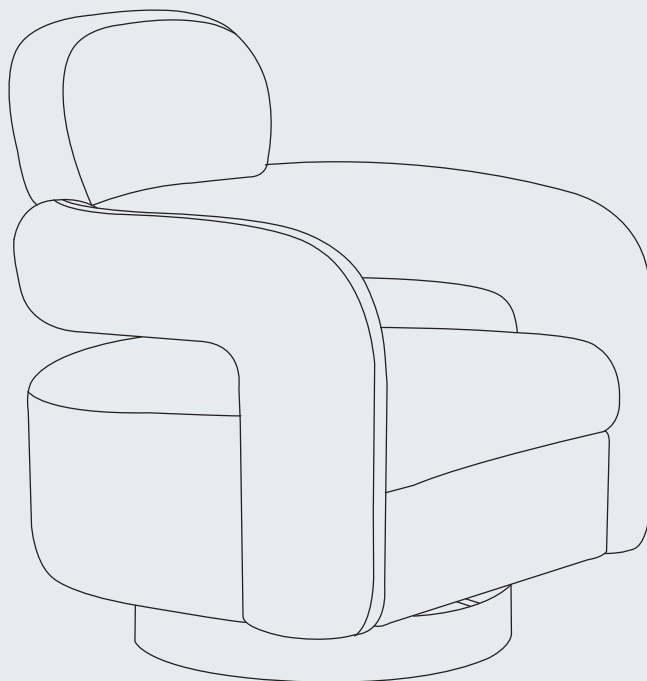

The assembly finishes here, enjoy the chair now.

## CLEANING TIPS

**REGULAR CLEAN:** Use a mixture of warm water and mild soap. Gently scrub the surface with a soft bristle brush to remove any dirt or stains.

**QUICK CLEAN:** You can simply wipe down the furniture with a damp cloth.
