## Product Description

## Product Features

- Withstands autoclave cycles for several hours at temperatures up to $350^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\left(177^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\right)$ and $400^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\left(204^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\right)$ exposure for shorter periods.
- Extruded PTFE film tape lies flatter than typical skived PTFE film tapes.
