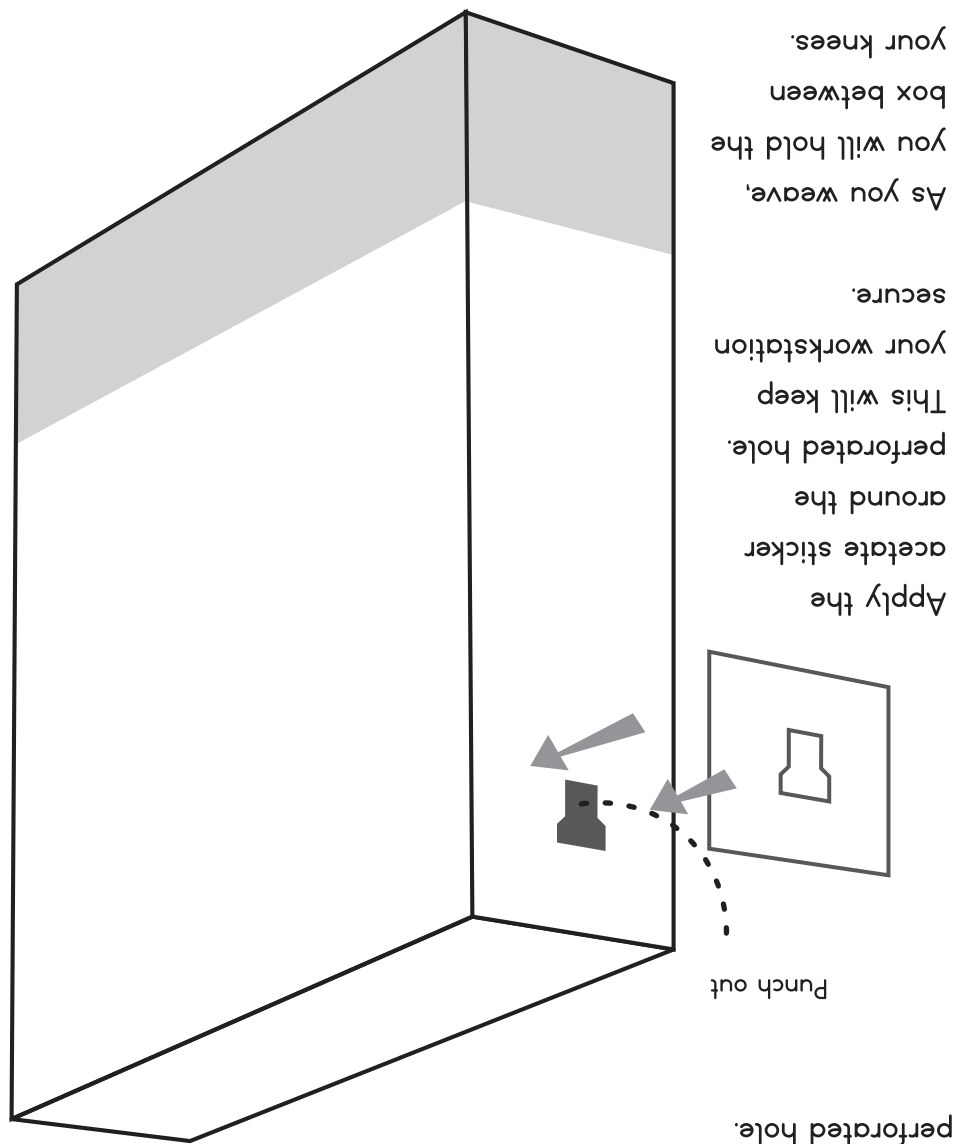


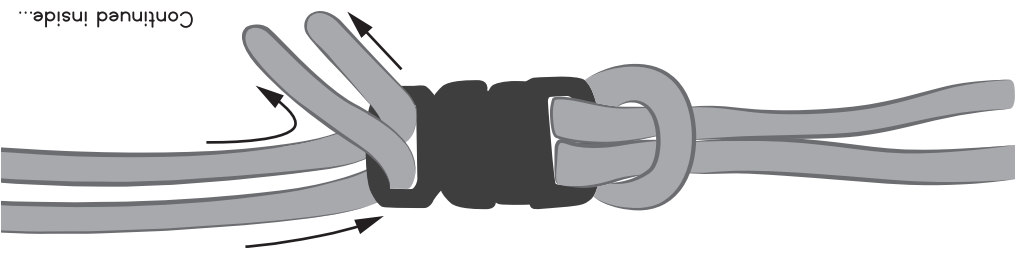
Fun Fact - Paracord was originally used to suspend parachutes. Today this cord has many uses, including bracelet making.



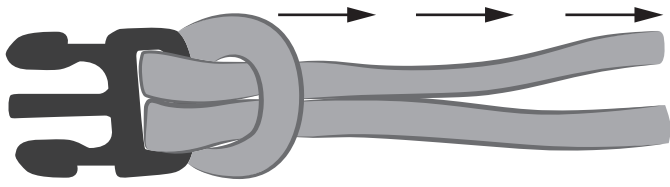
The side of your box features a neat workstation for you to create color cord bracelets. Carefully punch out the performed hole.

Apply the acetate sticker around the performed hole. This will keep your workstation secure. As you weave, you will hold the box between your knees.

## YOUR WORKSTATION

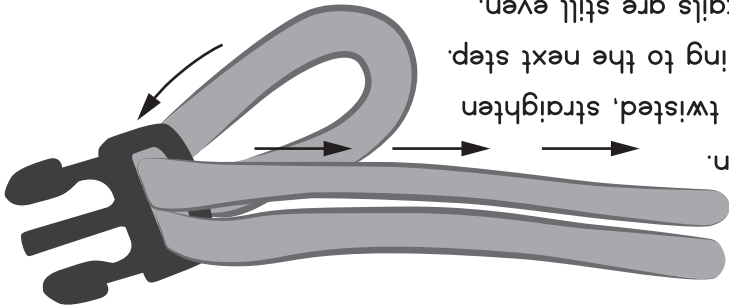


Rehook the other side of the buckle and pull the tails through.

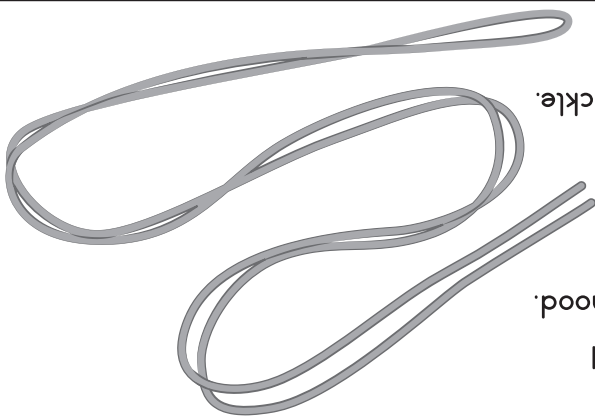


Pull the tails through the loop as shown.

Make sure the tails are still even. If the loop gets twisted, straighten it out before going to the next step.



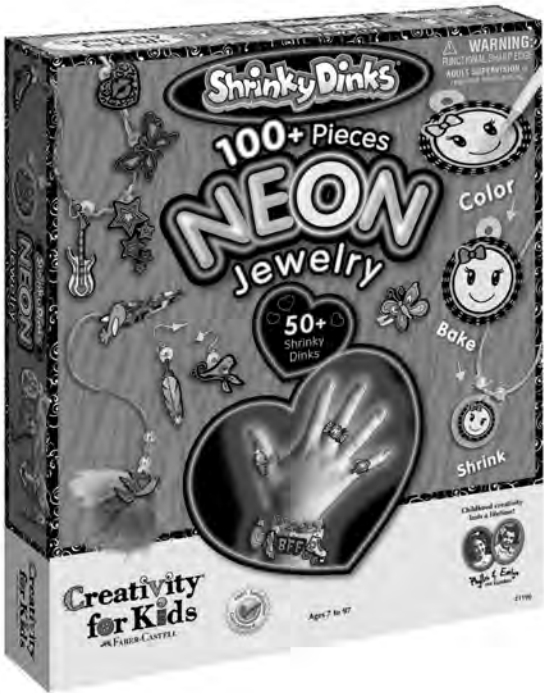
Pull the tails of the cord through the buckle as shown.



Select the color cord that matches your mood. Match the two tails together so that you can pull them through the buckle.

Orange = CONFIDENT

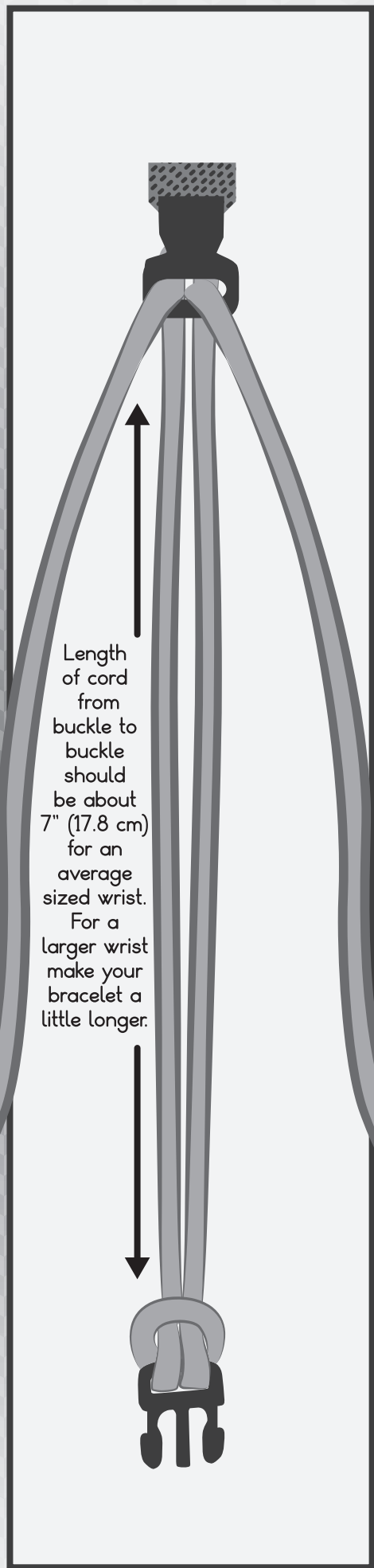
Purple = CREATIVE

# CREATING YOUR BRACELET

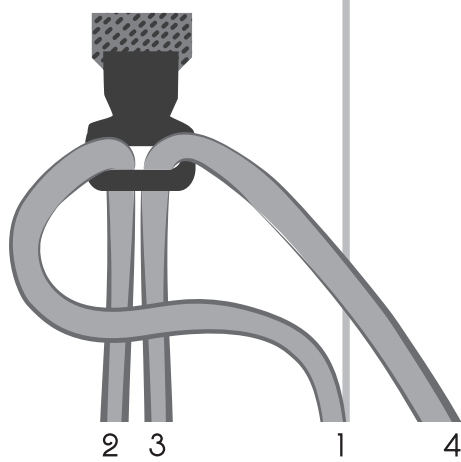
Unhook the buckle and insert it into the workstation on the side of your box as shown.



Length of cord from buckle to buckle should be about 7" (17.8 cm) for an average sized wrist. For a larger wrist make your bracelet a little longer.

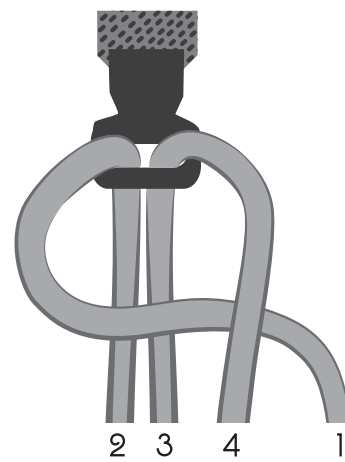
Line the bottom buckle up with the picture printed on the side of the box,

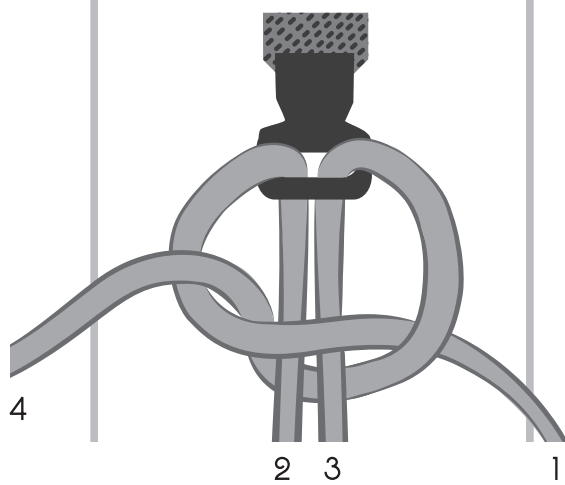
Cross the left cord (1) over the two center cords (2 and 3), creating a loop on the left side.

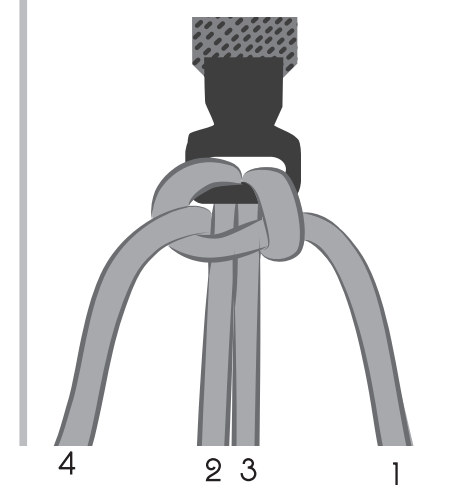
Place the right cord (4) over the left cord (1).

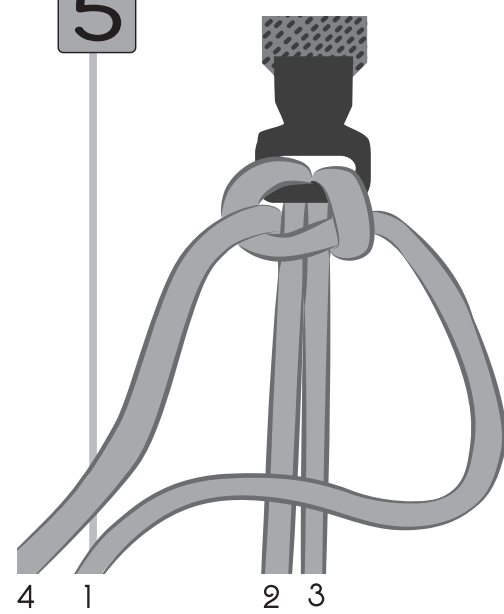
Pass the right cord (4) under the two center cords (2 and 3) and up through the loop you made on the left.

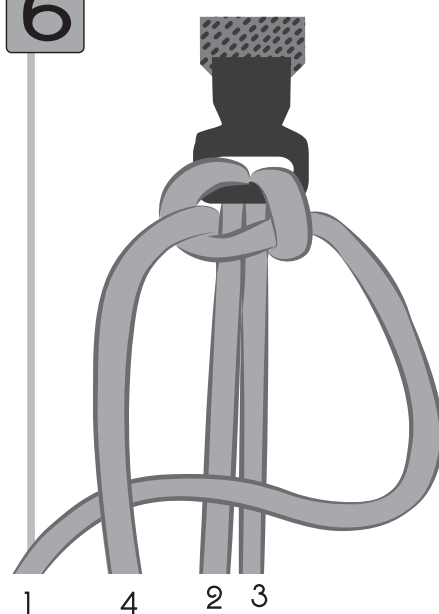
Pull left and right cords (1 and 4) to tighten the knot.

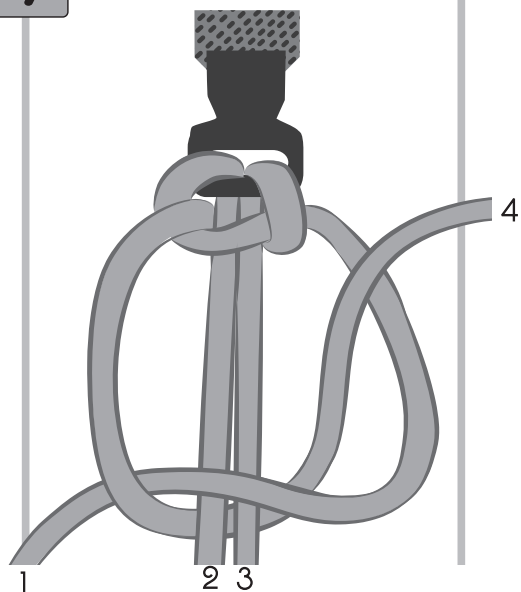
Tie the same knot starting on the right side. Cross the right cord (now 1) over the center cords (2 and 3) creating a loop on the right side.

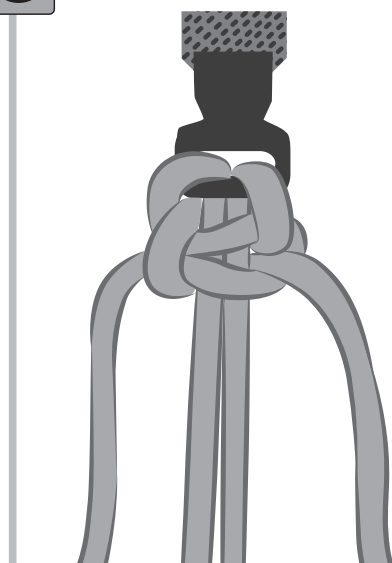
Cross the left cord (now 4) over the right (1).

Pass the left cord (4) under the two center cords (2 and 3) and up through the loop you made on the right.

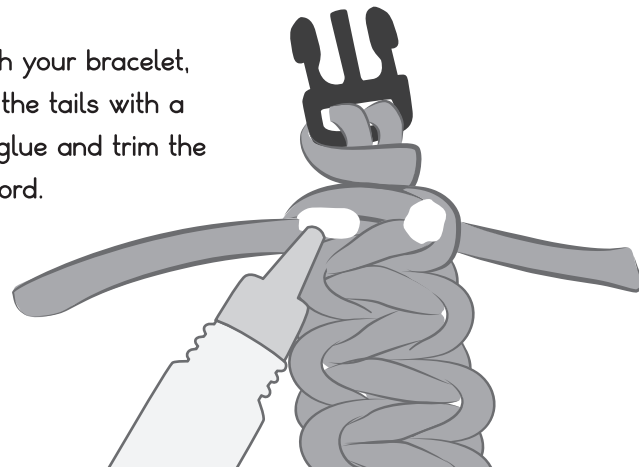

Pull the left and right cords (1 and 4) to tighten the knot.

Follow the steps and continue making knots until you reach the buckle at the other end.

To finish your bracelet, secure the tails with a dot of glue and trim the extra cord.



Once the glue is dry, accent your buckle with a cute sticker.
