REQUIRED: Calculate the following ratios for the year ended 31 December 2018:

ANSWERS

1. Gross profit ratio = $\frac{\text{Gross profit}}{\text{Revenue}} \times 100 = \frac{800,000}{1,200,000} \times 100 = 66.67\%$

2. Operating ratio = $\frac{\text{Operating expenses}}{\text{Revenue}} \times 100 = \frac{300,000}{1,200,000} \times 100 = 25\%$

3. Operating profit ratio = $\frac{\text{Operating profit}}{\text{Revenue}} \times 100 = \frac{500,000}{1,200,000} \times 100 = 41.67\%$

4. Profit before tax ratio = $\frac{\text{Profit before tax}}{\text{Revenue}} \times 100 = \frac{300,000}{1,200,000} \times 100 = 25\%$

5. Profit after tax ratio = $\frac{\text{Profit after tax}}{\text{Revenue}} \times 100 = \frac{200,000}{1,200,000} \times 100 = 16.67\%$
