Getting Started

Important information about the paint

- The paint included is a specially formulated non-toxic, ceramic paint that dries permanently on most surfaces, so be careful.
- Cover your work surface with a newspaper. Have a cup of water and paper towels handy.
- Wear a smock or old clothes. This ceramic paint can stain. Clean up any spills immediately with soap and water.
- Paint can settle and separate over time. Mix each color thoroughly before you begin painting. If the paint seems too thick, stir in a drop or two of water.
- Before changing colors, rinse and dry your brush thoroughly.

Although this paint is non-toxic, we suggest that you use your tea set for decorative purposes only.

Painting Your Tea Set

- Wash and dry the tea set before you begin painting.
- Decide on a design for your tea set. You may want to sketch out your ideas on paper before you begin painting.

- You can paint the tea set to match your room, your teddy bear or even your favorite collectable doll. Think up your own designs or look in magazines to get ideas.
- You can make new colors by mixing the paint. To make soft pastel colors, try mixing in some white paint. Combine colors to make new shades and think up your own unique combinations.
- If you make a mistake, wipe off the paint while it is still wet and start again.

Helpful Painting Tips

- To paint dots or fine lines, use the tip of your paintbrush handle.
- When you have finished painting your tea set pieces, set them aside to dry. Allow them to dry thoroughly before handling.
- To clean your tea set, gently wipe the pieces with a damp cloth. Dry them immediately. Do not soak the pieces in water.
- Save any leftover paint to touch up your designs as needed.

You can host a pretend tea party with your dolls and stuffed animals. You can even invite some friends over and pretend to have a lovely little lunch.
