
IMPORTANT


Carefully remove all the parts from the carton and place them individually on a soft cloth to prevent scratches or other damage.

Carefully and strictly follow these assembly instructions to ensure a completed product as designed.

This product is made of aluminum. Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble and only tighten bolts until snug. Over tightening can damage the aluminum.








Assembly Instructions 2/6

IMPORTANT

(See Figure 1)

- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the bolts until each part is properly assembled.
- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.
- Keep Hex Wrench as the bolts may need to be tightened in the future.



Attach Legs (F) to Seat (A) with Head Cap Bolts (short), Spring Washers and Flat Washers.





Figure 2 STEP 2

Attach Arms (B) and (C) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (middle), Spring Washers and Flat Washers, tightening Head Cap Bolts only halfway. (See Figure 2)

Assembly Instructions 4/6



Insert Axle (H) into unit.

Orientate Wheels (G) so large hole in center of Wheels (G) is to outside of unit, then attach Wheels (G) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (short), Spring Washers and Flat Washers, tightening Head Cap Bolts only halfway. (See Figure 3)

Lock Axle (H) in place by inserting Short Bolts into per-drilled holes in unit, then tighten bolts. (See Figure 4)






Assembly Instructions 5/6



STEP 4

Attach Support (E) to Back (D) with Head Cap Bolts, Spring Washers, Flat Washers and Plastic Washers, tightening Head Cap Bolts only halfway. (See Figure 5)




Assembly Instructions 6/6



STEP 5

Turn unit from Step 3 over to its upright position.

Attach Back (D) to unit with Head Cap Bolts (long), Spring Washers, Flat Washers and Plastic Washers, tightening Head Cap Bolts only halfway. (See Figure 6)

Tighten all bolts used in Steps 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Cover center wheel holes with Caps.

Level unit by adjusting the adjustable levelers on bottom of unit. (See Figure 7)

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

NEVER

allow liquids to remain on furniture. Absorption causes parts to warp and split and finishes to delaminate.

NEVER

use glass cleaners on finished furniture. Ammonia chemically attacks the finish.



Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.

PREVENT CRACKING



Do not place in direct sunlight.

PREVENT FADING



Do not write directly on surface.

PREVENT MARKING



Do not place hot objects on surface.

PREVENT FINISH DAMAGE



Do not use rubber based placemats.

PREVENT DISCOLORING



Do not use commercial waxes and polishes.

PREVENT YELLOWING

CLEAN

with a soft cloth moistened in lukewarm soap and water. Buff with a dry clean cloth.
