FOLDING FOR STORAGE

- 1. Remove Tray.
- 2. Remove Seat.
- 3. Raise Safety Bar to top position.
- 4. Push button on front of Platform while squeezing lever underneath platform and lift up to fold.
- 5. Lower the Safety Bar.

TO CLEAN

5-point harness: Machine wash, warm water, gentle cycle. Do not use chlorine-based bleach. Hang to dry. Do not dry clean.

Seat Cushion: Hand wash cold. Line dry.

Tray: Dishwasher-safe; top rack only. Use normal settings. Do not use high temperature setting (sani-cycle). Or tray can be washed in warm water using mild liquid soap. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.

Frame and Seat: Wipe surface with a damp cloth or sponge using mild liquid soap. Wipe with clean water. Air dry.



ASSEMBLE SEAT

NOTE: This is a one-time snap assembly. Do not attempt to separate the seat after the top and bottom are joined.

1. Slide the seat top into the seat bottom. It will click into place. [Fig. A1, A2]





ASSEMBLE FRAME

1. Slide Step/Footrest up onto

2. Shoulder straps of the harness have already been threaded through. For a smaller child, use the lower two slots. For a taller child, use the higher slots. [Fig. B]




Insert Front Leg into Main Frame.
 [Fig. D] Ensure pins pop through the holes and lock into place.
 NOTE: Front legs are longer than back legs.




Main Frame until it clicks into place.

3. Insert Back Leg into Main Frame. [Fig. E] Ensure pins pop through the holes and lock into place.




4. Attach Upper Frame to Main Frame. [Fig. F] Ensure pins pop through the holes and lock into place.




HIGH CHAIR MODE

Attach Seat to Upper Frame

 Ensure Safety Bar is fully lowered. Push side buttons on Upper Frame to adjust Safety Bar. [Fig. G]




Place the bottom hooks of the Chair onto the Safety Bar. [Fig. H]




HIGH CHAIR MODE (CONT.)

- 3. Push down on the button at top back of the Seat while squeezing the lever to release the lock. [Fig. I]
- 4. Push down on the Seat to lock into place. Always ensure seat is firmly locked in place before use.



Attaching Tray to Seat

- 1. Hold Tray over Seat. Align slots on Tray above notches on side of Seat. Holding Tray level, gently flex the sides of the Tray over the notches on the seat and connect. You will hear a click. [Fig. J]
- 2. To change position, gently flex the sides out and slide over the notches into the other position.




Removing Tray:

Gently flex the sides to disconnect the Tray from the notches and lift the tray off.

TODDLER TOWER MODE

- 1. Remove tray.
- 2. Remove Seat by pushing down on the button at top of the seat back while squeezing the lever to release the lock. [Fig. K]
- 3. Detach the bottom hooks from the safety bar.
- 4. Push the side buttons on the Upper Frame to lift the Safety Bar to the top position.



ADJUSTING HEIGHTS

Height can be adjusted for both High Chair and Toddler Tower Mode.

Adjust the leg pins to desired level. Ensure pins pop through the holes and lock into place. Always make sure the product is level before using. [Fig. L]
