

2019 HYLAND VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

VINEYARD

Located in the McMinnville sub-AVA, Hyland Vineyard is one of Oregon's largest and oldest vineyards. The remote site sits in the eastern foothills of Coast Range, benefiting from cooler temperatures in the summer and warmer temperatures in the winter. The vineyard's established plantings thrive in the soil, microclimate, and high elevation unique to this site, which consistently produces fruit with structured tannins and bright acidity. Founding Winemaker Lynn Penner-Ash has been sourcing Pinot Noir and Riesling from the vineyard since 2008.

2019 VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season started cool with small amounts of rain followed by warmer than average summer temperatures. As harvest approached, cooler fall temperatures allowed us to capture ripeness and flavor intensity in the grapes.

TASTING NOTES

Layers of dark fruit, tea leaves, and black cherry. Spiced oak, black cherry and brown sugar give this wine a sweet intensity, mid-palate weight, and fine grain tannins.
