

Decorate & Display 3 Tulle Butterflies

Helpful Hint: Plan your designs before you begin, that way you'll have plenty of paint for all 3 butterflies.

painting tips:

- Wear old clothes and cover your work area.
- The pink and blue sparkle paint and the purple and silver glitter gel are washable while wet, but may stain some surfaces or become harder to remove when dry. For best results, wipe any spills before the paint dries.
- To prevent paint or glitter gel from getting on your work surface, prop the butterflies up using their antennae and legs.
 The wings should be off your work surface.
 Tuck the hanging string under the butterfly.





more painting tips on back...

- Work from the top of the butterfly down so you don't smear your designs.
- Gently squeeze the tube and begin painting. Use the fine tip to draw your designs for a more solid look. Use the paint brush to brush the paint or glitter gel around the wings for a more shimmery and sheer look.
- When your designs are dry, stick the rhinestones onto your butterflies for even more sparkle and shine.



Displaying the Butterflies:

Ask for adult permission and assistance with this step.

When your designs are completely dry, hang the butterflies by the hanging string around your bedroom or prop them up on a flat surface with their legs and wings.
