

2021 BELLA VIDA VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

VINEYARD

Nestled in the Dundee Hills sub-AVA, Bella Vida Vineyard has helped define the signature Penner-Ash style – wines with fruit driven elegance and texture. The red-clay Jory soil holds moisture producing classic characteristics of red, lush fruit. The clone 777 block provides dense, sweet blackberry fruit, whereas the block planted to clone 667 offers spice and nuanced red fruit. Clone 115 brings intense red almost black fruit, and the 113 clonal block adds a bright black cherry perfumed note.

2021 VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season began with a winter ice storm, followed by rain at bloom and a heat dome in June. Overall yields were decreased due to the rain at bloom, but flavor intensity remained strong. A warm growing season kept berries small and concentrated. Much needed rains in early September extended the growing season, allowing the grapes a little extra hang time to build up flavor and balance acidity.

TASTING NOTES

Vanilla, ripe red raspberry, and floral notes jump from the glass. Flavors of warm Oregon strawberries accompany white pepper and oak, bringing a roundness to the mid-palate and an elegant, savory finish.
