
Freestanding Vanity INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS






1. Prepare Frame

- Insert 2 wooden dowels (C) into the middle panel (1) as shown.
- Insert 1 wooden dowels (C) into each end of the rear top bar (3) as shown. Repeat to the front top bar (4).
- Insert 4 wooden dowels (C) into the rear bottom bar (5) as shown.



2. Prepare Side Panels


- · Insert 2 wooden dowels (C) into the right side panel (6) as shown.
- \cdot Screw 6 cam bolts (A) into the right side panel (6) as shown.
- \cdot Repeat the above steps for the left side panel (7).


3. Assemble Frame

- Use 2 cam locks (B) to connect the rear top bar (3) and left side panel (7) as shown. Repeat this process to secure the front top bar (4) and the rear bottom bar (5) to the left side panel (7) as shown.
- Slide the middle panel (1) and middle support (2) in between the top and rear bars (3,4,5) as shown. Be sure to line the middle panel (1) up using the cut out notches.
- \cdot Use 2 cam locks (B) to connect the rear top bar (3) and right side panel (6) as shown. Repeat this process to secure the front top bar (4) and the rear bottom bar (5) to the right side panel (6) as shown.



4. Construct Base


- \cdot Align the base panel (8) with the vanity frame as shown.
- \cdot Use 13 screws (D) to secure the base panel (8) as shown.
- \cdot Secure the base support bar (10) to the base panel (8) as shown using 4 screws (D).



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
5. Attach Legs

- Insert 2 wooden dowels (C) into each leg set (9) as shown.
- Place a foam pad (F) onto the bottom of the legs sets (9) according to the diagram below.
- \cdot Attach each leg set (9) to the cabinet base (8) as shown.
- Finish securing the legs sets (9) into place by using 4 screws (D).



6. Attach Brackets


- \cdot Secure the middle panel (1) into place by lining up a bracket (H) against the middle panel (1) and the rear top bar (3).
- \cdot Use 2 screws (G) to secure bracket into place.
- \cdot On the opposite side of the middle panel (1), line up a bracket (H) against the middle panel (1) and the front top bar (4).
- \cdot Use 2 screws (G) to secure bracket into place.



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
7. Attach Hinges

- \cdot Remove threaded caps from bottom of screw in a hinge (E).
- \cdot Align caps in designated holes of the left side door (12). Using a mallet, hammer caps into the holes, making sure that each cap is open at the top.
- \cdot Align hinge (E) with the left side door (12) as shown. Then, screw the hinge (E) into the threaded caps until tight. Repeat the above process with an additional hinge (E).
- Once the above steps are completed to the left side door panel (12), repeat all the steps to both right side door panels (11).




8. Attach Doors

- \cdot Using 2 screws per hinge (E), connect the right door panel (11) to the cabinet body as shown.
- Connect the remaining right door (11) to the middle of the cabinet body as shown using 2 screws per hinge (E).
- Attach the left side door (12) using 2 screws per hinge (E) as shown.




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9. Optional: Secure Vanity to Wall



10. Vanity Top Installation

- Install faucet and drain according to manufacturer's installation instructions. Do not overtighten, this may cause the sink to crack.
- \cdot Set the vanity top on top of the vanity base, checking the location of the p-trap and drain.
- Remove vanity top from vanity base. Apply a thin bead of silicone around the vanity base and set the vanity top carefully in place.
- · Remove excess silicone with a wet cloth.
