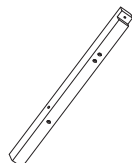

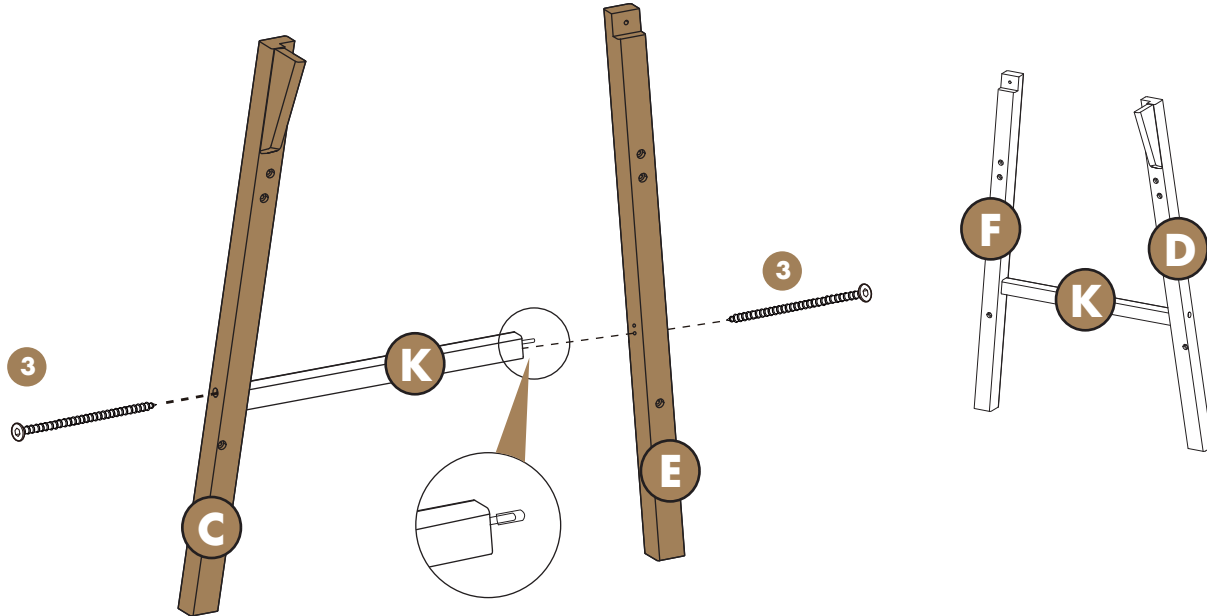
Please refer back to this image during the assembly process for part placement.

Step 1: Assemble the Left Legs and the Right Legs

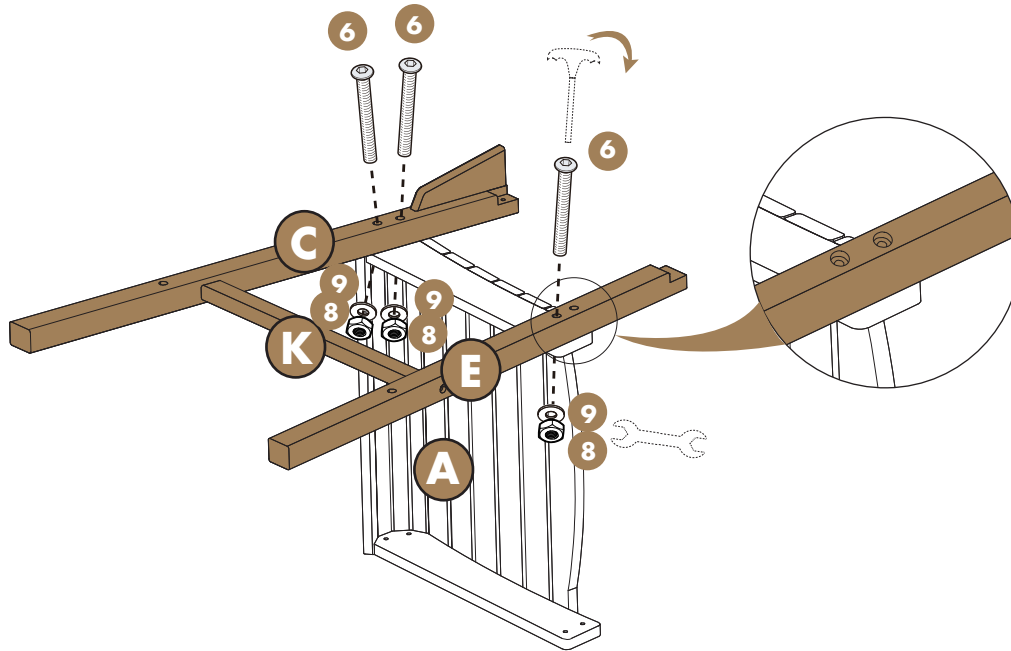
- Remove the plastic protection tube from the pre-installed steel pins in **Part K (Side Rail)** and locate the pins to the holes in **Part E (Left Rear Leg)** and **Part C (Left Front Leg)** (see image below).
- Attach **Left Legs (Part C and Part E)** to **Part K (Side Rail)** using **2 - M6 Screw (#3)** (see image below).
- Do the same to attach **Right Legs (Part D and Part F)** to **Part K (Side Rail)** using **2 - M6 Screw (#3)**.
- Do not fully tighten the bolts yet. Tighten them to approximately 70% to allow for adjustments during final assembly.

Step 2: Attach the Left Legs to the Chair Seat

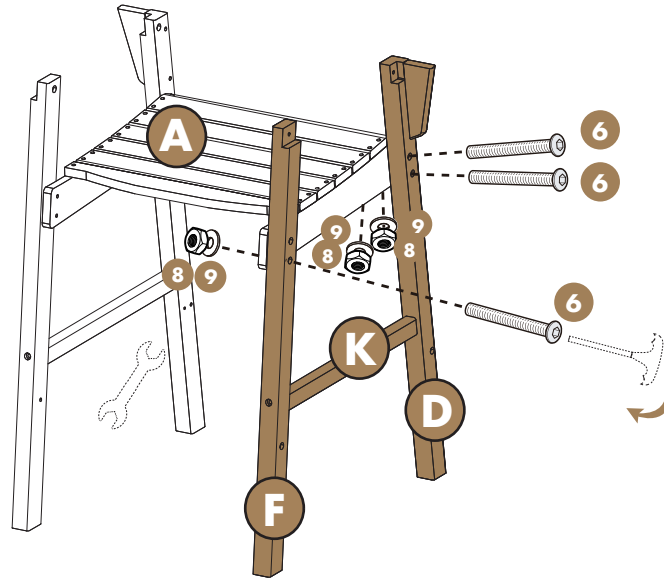
- Place **Part A (Chair Seat)** on a flat, stable surface (see image below).
- Attach the combined **Left Leg (Part C, Part K and Part E)** to **Part A (Chair Seat)** using **3 - sets** of the **M6 Bolt (#6)**, **M6 Washer (#9)**, and **M6 Nut (#8)** (see image below).

Step 3: Attach the Right Legs to the Chair Seat

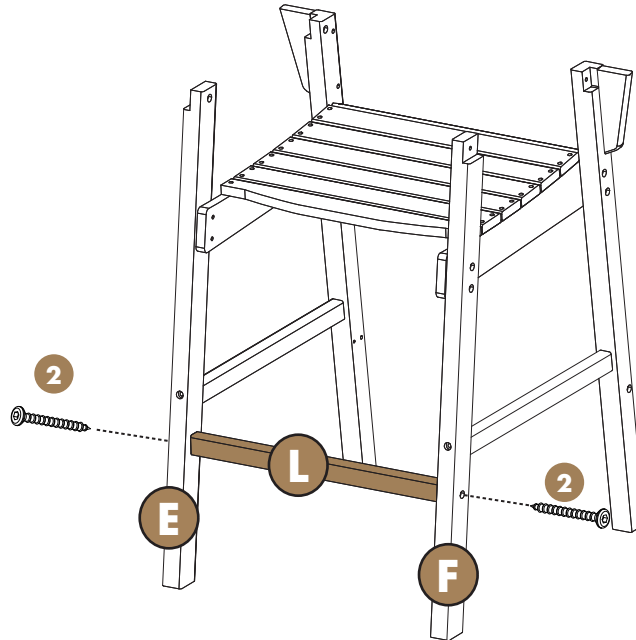
- Mirror the previous step (Step 2) on the opposite side. Secure the combined **Right Legs (Part D, Part K and Part F)** to **Part A (Chair Seat)** using **3 - sets of the M6 Bolt (#6), M6 Washer (#9), and M6 Nut (#8)** (see image below).

Step 4: Attach the Back Rail to the Rear Legs

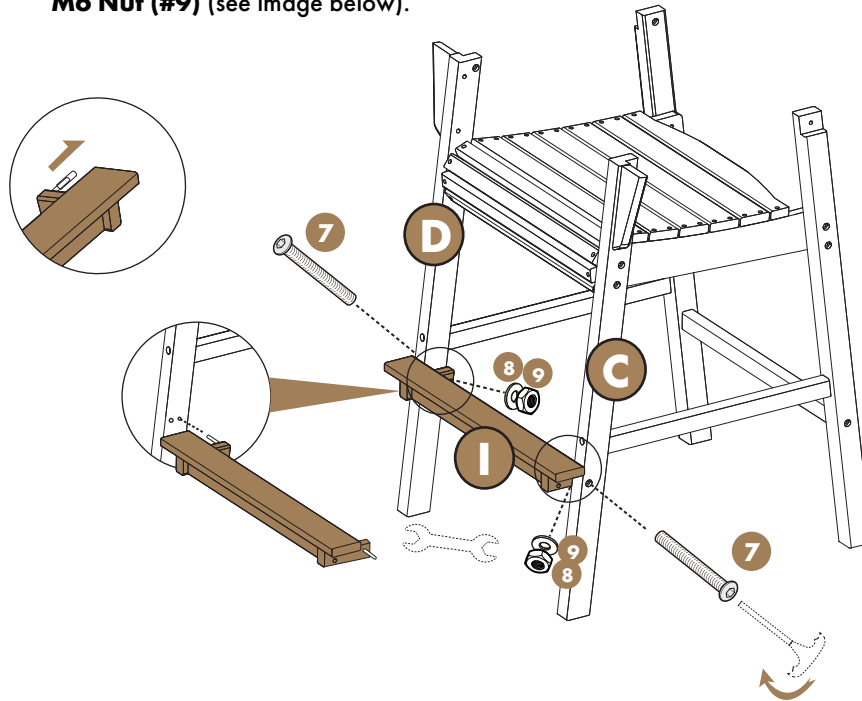
- Attach **Part L (Back Rail)** to **Rear Legs (Part E and Part F)** using **2 - M6 Screw (#2)** (see image below).

Step 5: Attach the Footrest to the Front Legs

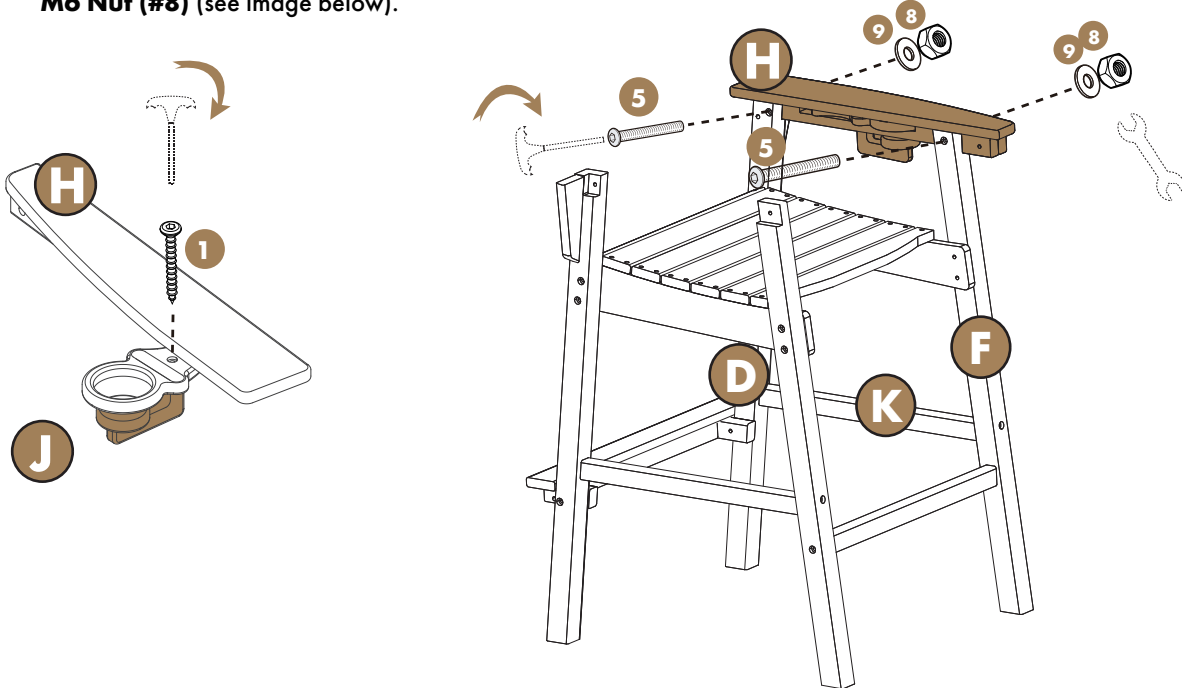
- Remove the plastic protection tube from the pre-installed pins in **Part I (Footrest)** and locate the pins to the hole in **Part D (Right Front Leg)** and **Part C (Left Front Leg)** (see image below).
- Attach **Part I (Footrest)** to the legs using **2 - sets of the M6 Bolt (#7), M6 Washer (#10), and M6 Nut (#9)** (see image below).

Step 6: Attach the Cup Holder to the Arm, and Arm to Chair

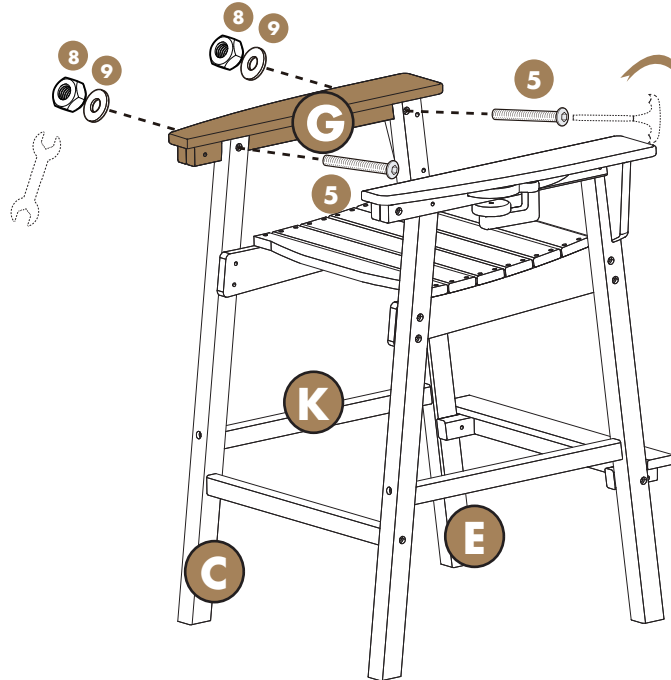
- Attach **Part J (Cup Holder)** to the bracket on the **Part H (Right Arm)** using **1 - M6 Screw (#1)** (see image below).
- Next, secure the combined **Part H (Right Arm with Cup Holder)** unit to the **Right Chair Legs (Part D, Part K and Part F)**. This requires **2 - sets of the M6 Bolt (#5), M6 Washer (#9), and M6 Nut (#8)** (see image below).

Step 7: Attach the Second Arm to the Chair

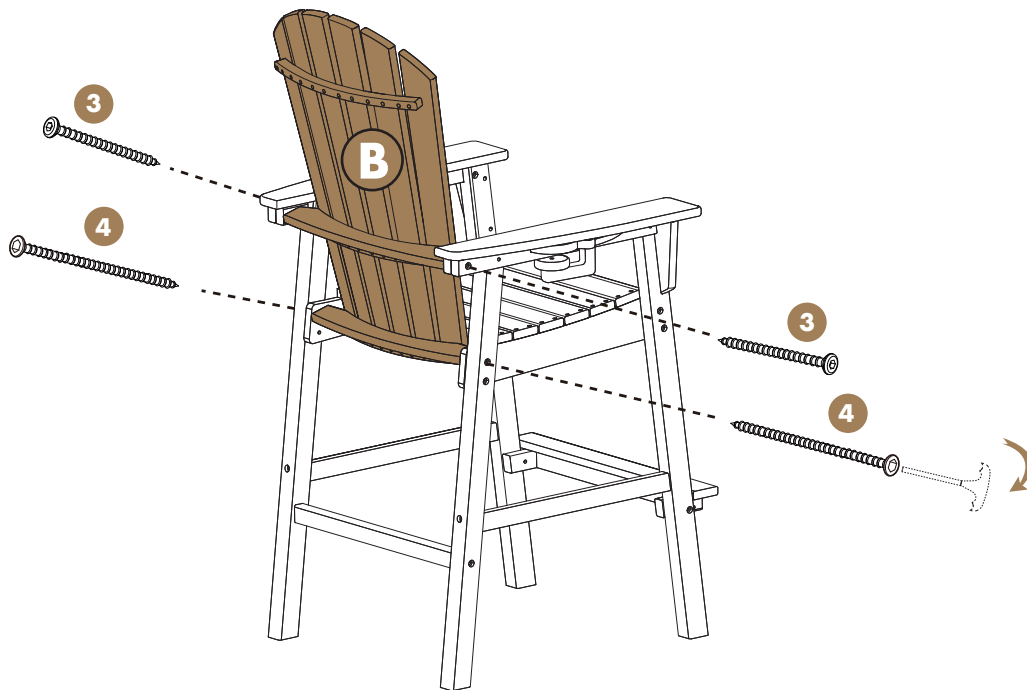
- Mirror the previous step (Step 6) on the opposite side. Secure **Part G (Left Arm)** to the **Left Chair Legs (Part C, Part K and Part E)**. This requires **2 - sets** of the **M6 Bolt (#5)**, **M6 Washer (#9)**, and **M6 Nut (#8)** (see image below).

Step 8: Attach the Backrest to the Assembled Frame

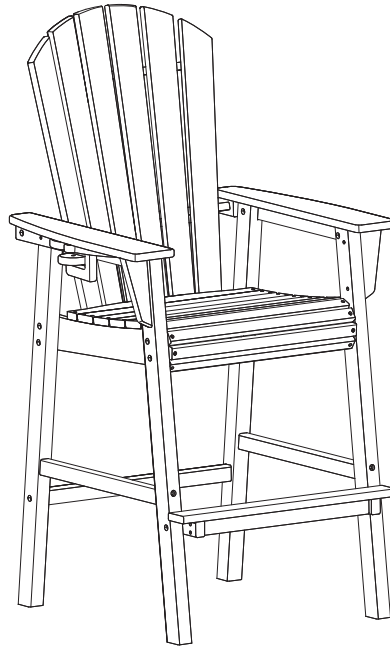
- Attach the **Part B (Chair Backrest)** to the assembled frame. Use **2 - M6 Screw (#3)** and **2 - M6 Screw (#4)** to secure it (see image below).

Step 9: Final Tightening and Stability Check

- Tighten all previously installed screws, bolts, and nuts. Check every connection to ensure the chair is steady and stable.

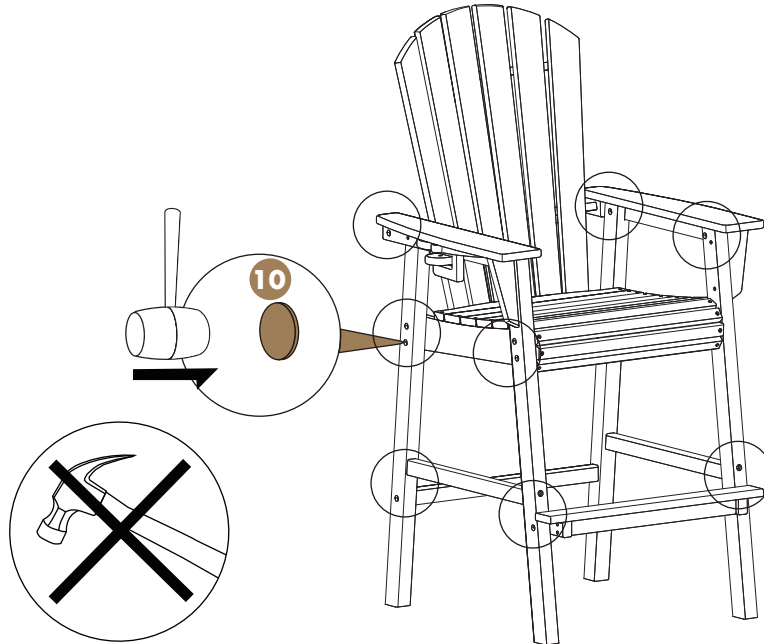

Step 10: Apply the Screw Hole Plugs

- Cover all exposed screw holes using **22 - Screw Hole Plug (#10)**. Insert all plugs into the exposed screw holes. Gently tap each plug into place using a rubber mallet to prevent damage. Ensure each plug is fully seated and flush with the chair surface (see image below).

ATTENTION: Do not use a metal hammer as it will damage the poly lumber.



- **REGULAR CLEAN:** Mix **warm water and mild soap**. Use a **soft bristle brush** to gently scrub the surface and remove any dirt or stains.
- **QUICK CLEAN:** Simply wipe the furniture down using a damp cloth.

Tip: Cleaning your furniture regularly helps maintain its aesthetic appeal and extends its lifespan.
