SCHEDULE 1 (1997)

1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 This schedule sets out the minimum standards for the design, construction, installation, testing and commissioning of water supply systems for buildings.

2.0 SCOPE

- 2.1 This schedule applies to all buildings, including residential, commercial, industrial and public buildings.
- 2.2 It covers the design, construction, installation, testing and commissioning of the water supply system from the point of entry to the building to the point of use.
- 2.3 It does not cover the design, construction, installation, testing and commissioning of the water supply system from the water main to the point of entry to the building.
- 2.4 It does not cover the design, construction, installation, testing and commissioning of the water supply system for the following:
 - (a) buildings with a maximum height of 10 metres;
 - (b) buildings with a maximum floor area of 1000 square metres;
 - (c) buildings with a maximum number of occupants of 100;
 - (d) buildings with a maximum number of floors of 3.

 - (a) buildings with a maximum height of 10 metres;
