

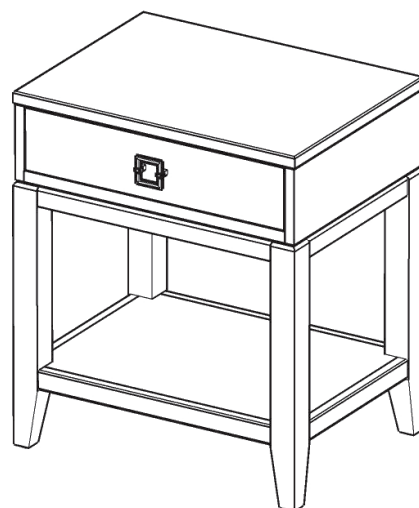

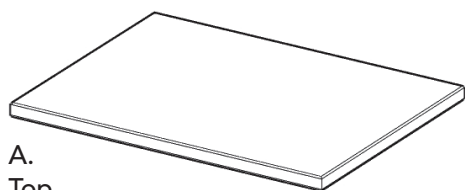
Carefully remove all the parts from the carton and place them individually on a soft cloth to prevent scratches or other damage.

Carefully and strictly follow these assembly instructions to ensure a completed product as designed.

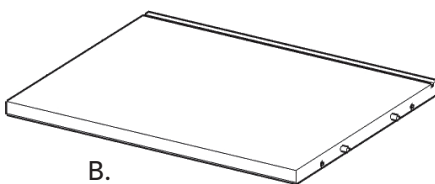

Assembly Instructions 2/6

IMPORTANT

- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the bolts until each part is properly assembled.
- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.
- Keep Hex Wrench as the bolts may need to be tightened in the future.

STEP 1

Insert Cam Lock Screws into pre-drilled holes in Top (A) and Side Panels (C), (D), then tighten. (See Figure 1)

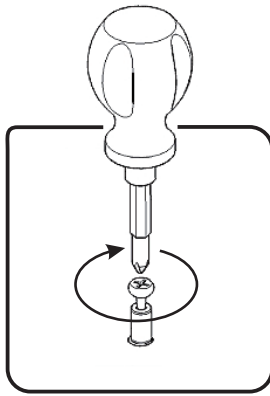
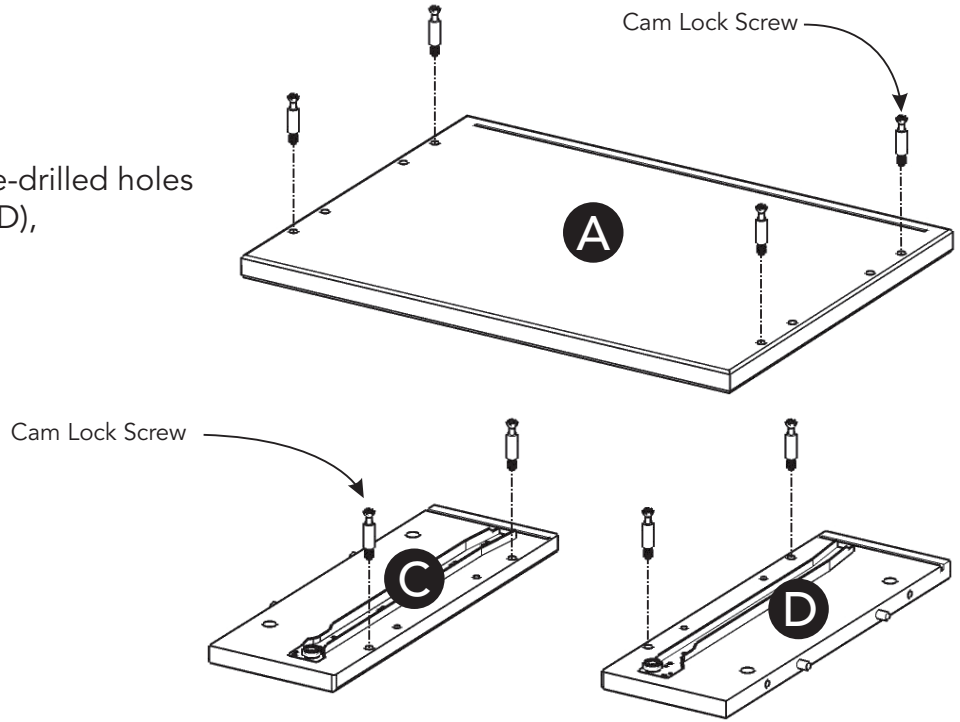

STEP 2

Attach Side Panels (C) and (D) to Bottom (B) with Cam Locks. (See Figure 2)

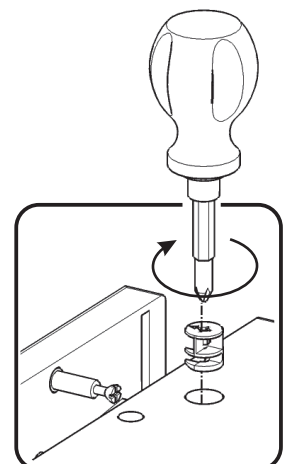
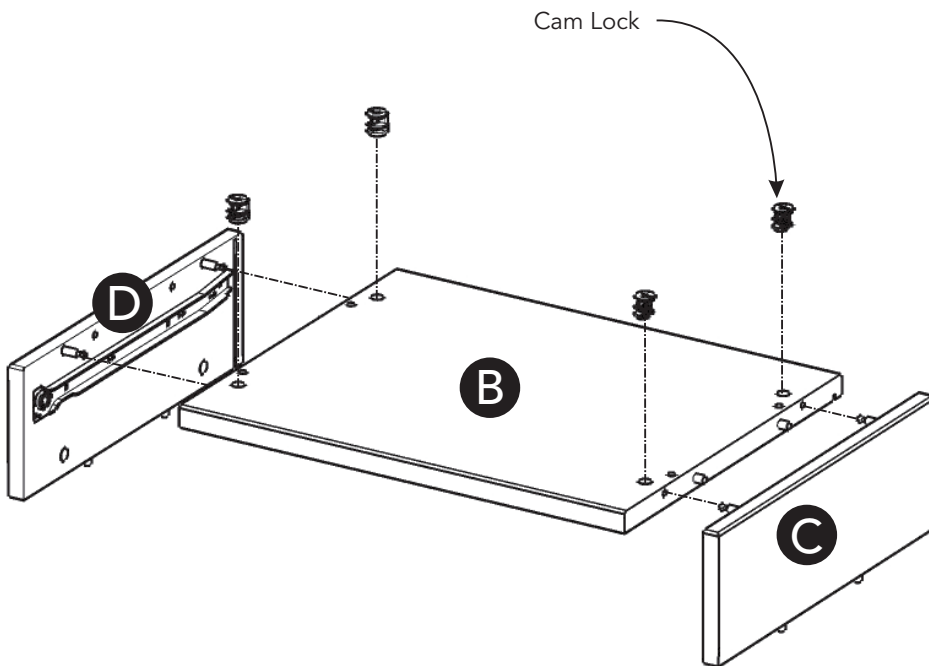
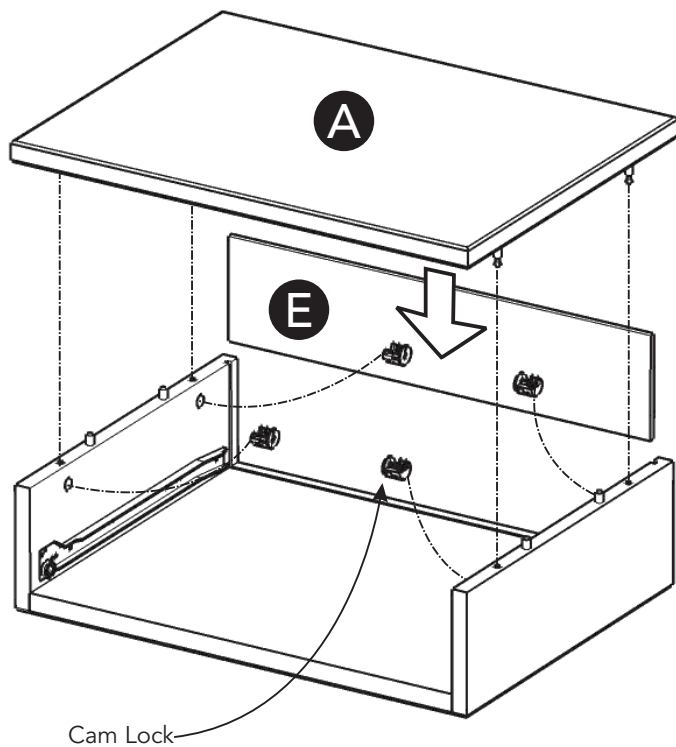

STEP 3

Turn unit over to its' upright position and place it on a soft cloth.

Slide Back Panel (E) into position.

Attach Top (A) to unit with Cam Locks.

STEP 4

Place unit upside down on a soft cloth.

Attach Side Frame (G) to unit with Flat Washers, Spring Washers and Head Cap Bolts, tightening bolts only halfway.
(See Figure 3)

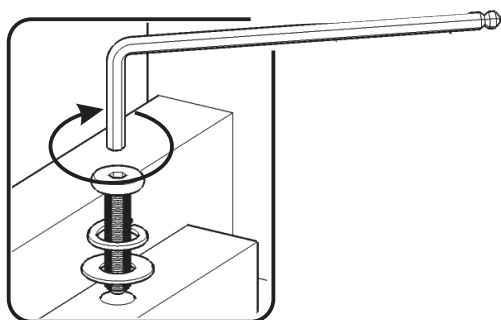
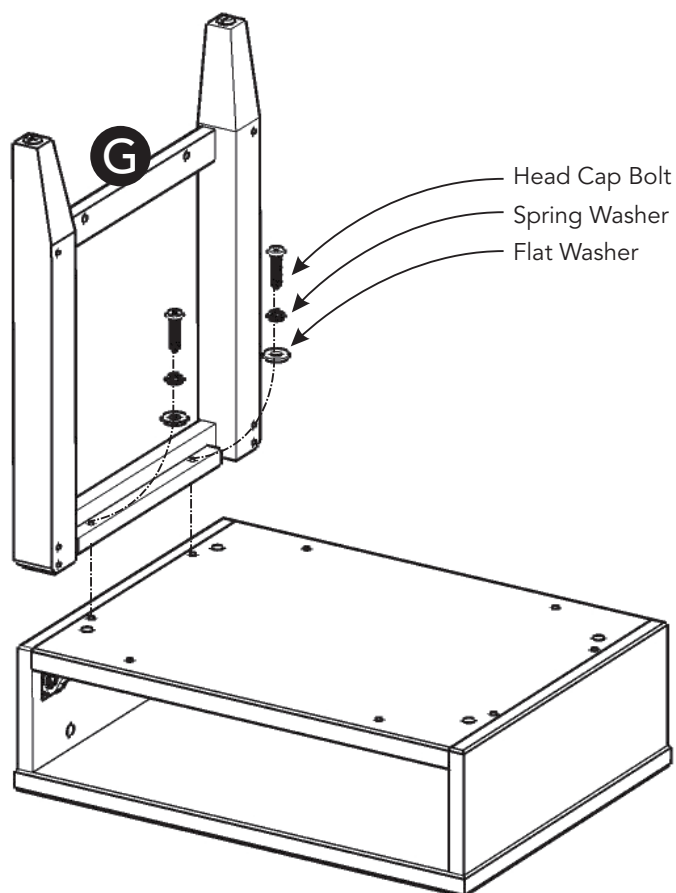
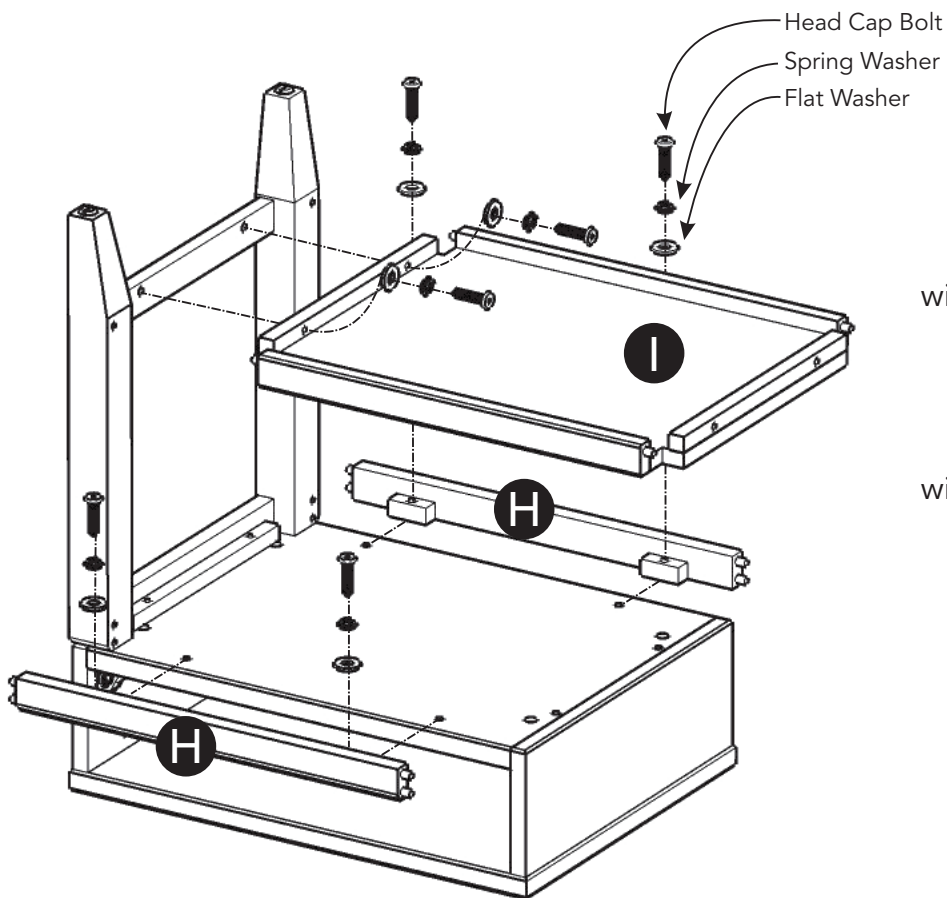

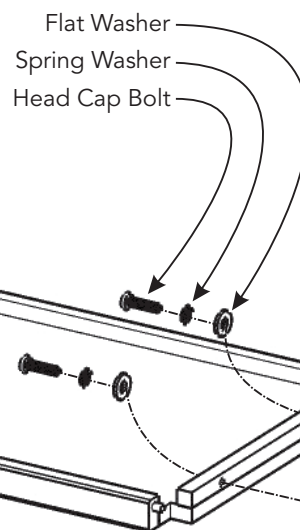




STEP 5

Attach Rails (H) to unit with Flat Washers, Spring Washers and Head Cap Bolts, tightening bolts only halfway.

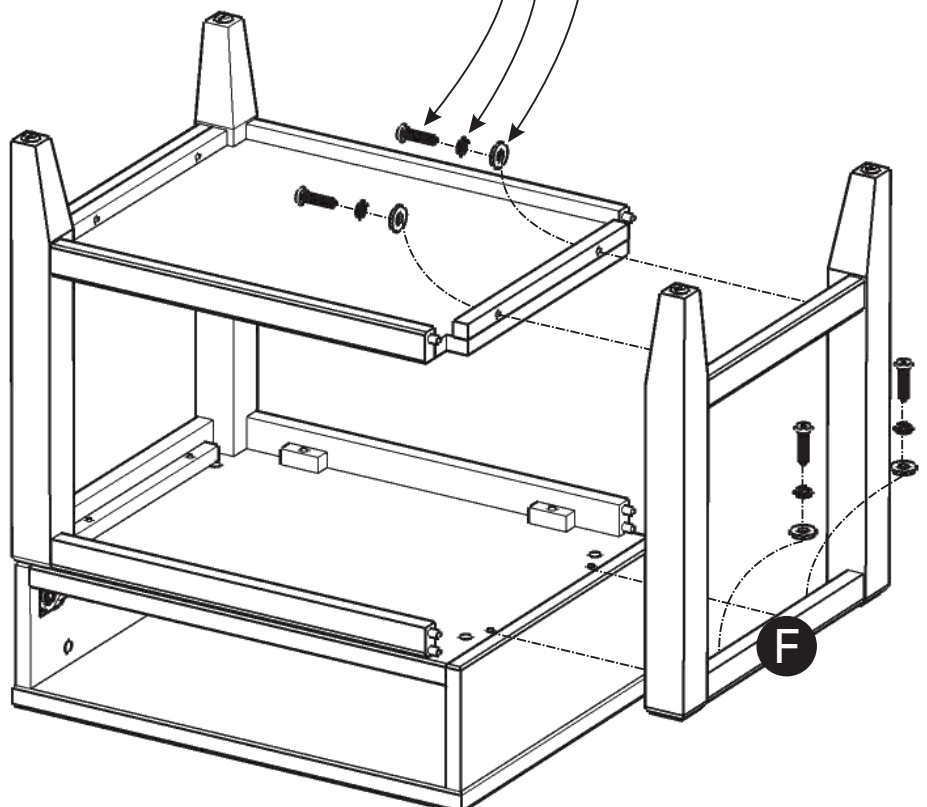
Attach Shelf (I) to unit with Flat Washers, Spring Washers and Head Cap Bolts, tightening bolts only halfway.



STEP 6

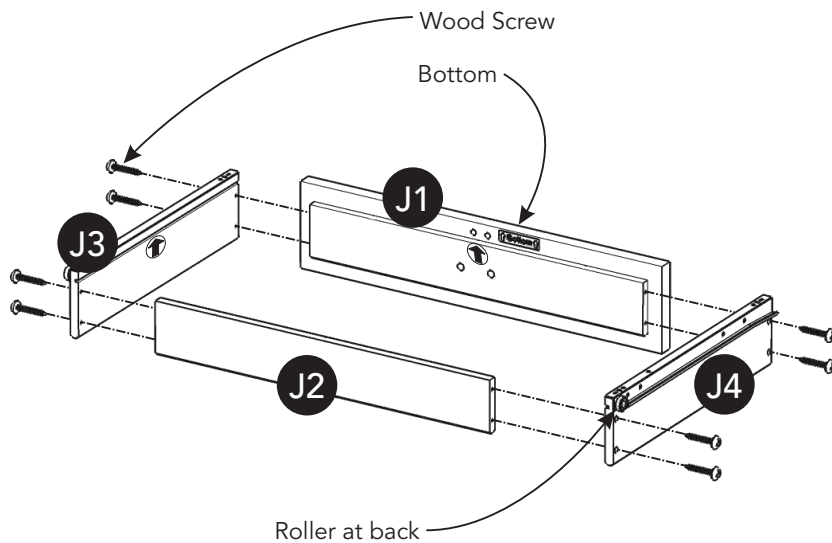
Attach Side Frame (F) to unit with Flat Washers, Spring Washers and Head Cap Bolts, tightening bolts only halfway.

Tighten all bolts used in Steps 4, 5 and 6.

Drawer (J)



STEP 7

Attach Drawer Front (J1) and Drawer Back (J2) to Drawer Side (J3) with Wood Screws.

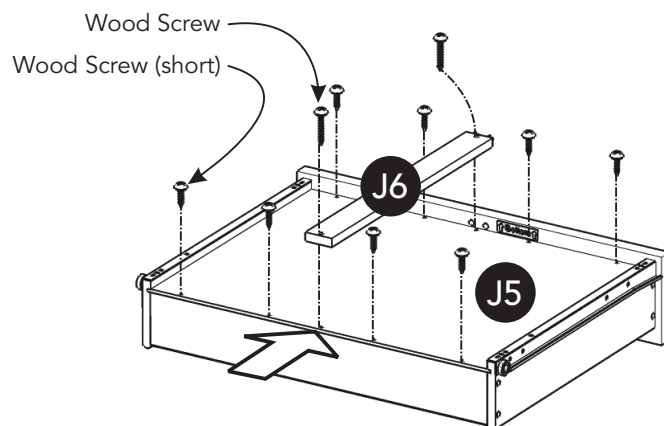
Attach Drawer Side (J4) to unit with Wood Screws.

STEP 8

Slide Drawer Bottom (J5) into groove.

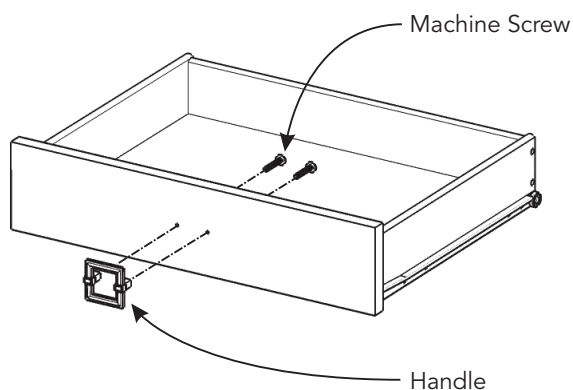
Attach Support (J6) to unit with Wood Screws.

Attach Drawer Bottom (J5) to unit with Wood Screws (short).

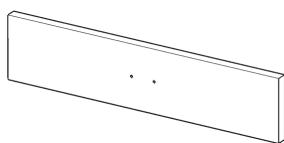

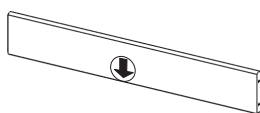
Attach Handle with Machine Screws.



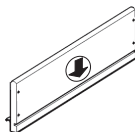

STEP 10

Turn unit over to its' upright position.

Slide Drawer (J) into position.

Level unit by adjusting the adjustable levelers on bottom of unit.
(See Figure 4)

Note: Unit must be level to work properly.

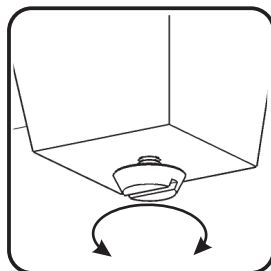
