Getting Started

Gardening can get a little messy. Cover your work area and have a cup of water and paper towels handy. It is helpful to have a plastic spoon for adding the potting mix to your container.

Layer

Open your bag of potting mix. Adding a little bit of water at a time, squish the bag until the mix clumps together like clay. If the potting mix is too wet, lay a dry paper towel over to soak up excess water.

Using a spoon, add about ¾ of your potting mix to cover the bottom of the container as shown. Press the soil down.

Slowly pour the sand into your container creating 2 layers as shown. Use a damp paper towel to remove any sand residue from the sides of the container.



READ THIS! Keep your container level when adding the sand and when decorating. Avoid tilting or shaking the container or the sand layers will mix. Pouring the sand close to the edge of the terrarium will help you see the layers better.

Plant

Add the white stones to the front of the terrarium and the remaining potting mix to the back as shown.

Sprinkle a few Chia seeds over the potting mix. Use your dropper to water them.



Pro-Tip - Plant just a few seeds at a time, save the rest to re-plant later. The chia seeds will not grow if you plant too many seeds too close together.

Decorate

Decorate the outside of the mushroom with the colorful stickers included. Refer to the pictures on the box and instructions for ideas. You can use all the stickers or just a few, it is up to you! You can even turn the container into a little gnome house.



Using the dimensional spots, decorate the lid. Avoid covering the holes – these provide oxygen for your garden.

Arrange the Gnome, snail and mini mushrooms inside, gently pushing the sticks down into the layers.

Carefully screw on the lid and leave in a sunny spot.



Water

As your seeds start to grow, use your water dropper to keep the soil damp. Use a dry paper towel to remove any excess moisture from inside the container.

Note - over time you may see some fuzzy mold growth on your chia seeds. Remove the lid and let your garden dry a bit - air circulation helps. This growth is not harmful. It is just nature's way of breaking down plant material to make new soil.

Over time, your garden will need to be replanted. You can use any leftover materials, or buy more sand, seeds, and soil at your local craft and garden supply stores.
