

THE BATTERY

1. The battery is the power source for the system.

2. It provides the energy needed to start the engine and to power the electrical system when the engine is not running.

3. The battery is connected to the engine and the electrical system through the battery cables.

4. The battery is located in the engine compartment and is secured by a battery hold-down.

5. The battery is filled with electrolyte and should be checked regularly.

6. The battery should be kept clean and free of corrosion.

7. The battery should be replaced when it is no longer able to hold a charge.

8. The battery should be disposed of properly.

9. The battery is a critical component of the vehicle's electrical system.

10. The battery should be inspected regularly for signs of wear and damage.

11. The battery should be replaced if it is found to be faulty.

1. The terminal post is the main connection point for the battery cable.

2. The terminal nut and washer are used to secure the terminal post to the battery terminal.
