

- abrasives in grits to cover almost any wet or dry sanding need, such as auto body, paint, wood, metal, plastics, glass or drywall
- Tear-resistant backing and anticlog coatings provide a long life and are ideal for hand sanding blocks and power tools with clampon attachment styles
- Full-sized 9 x 11 in. paper can be cut into 1/2, 1/3, or 1/4 sheet sizes depending on your application
- 20 pc. Aluminum oxide, used for metal, wood, and plastic, in 60 (4), 100 (6), 150 (6), and 220 (4) grits
- 10 pc. Garnet used primarily for woodworking in 60 (2), 80 (3), 150 (3), and 220 (2) grits
- 10 pc. Waterproof silicon carbide used for metal, plastic, and glass in 180 (2), 400 (3) and 600 (3), and 800 (2) grits

• For best results, it's recommended to use a sanding block to maintain a consistent, flat working surface. Begin with the coarsest grit and then gradually progress to finer grades
