WARNINGS

Read instruction carefully before installing. Before use, ensure that the bed rail is assembled and installed as described, that all attaching hardware is securely tightened, and that the bed rail is securely in place.

DO NOT use the bed rail as a handle for getting into or out of bed; this could result in personal injury and damage to the bed rail

DO NOT exert side pressure on the bed rail: this could deform or break it

DO NOT use the bed rail as a push handle for moving the bed; this could deform or break it

DO NOT use the bed rail if a proper fit in installation cannot be achieved. Contact your dealer.


INSTALLATION

 Prepare the bed in a flat position. The carton should include the following:




- Place crossbrace on the head end of the frame between the first and second spring.
- Turn the barrel so that the lock plate on the locking collar is facing down.

 Insert the lock plate on the far side of the bed so that it is under the lip of the frame.



- Push the crossbar together to allow for the locking collar to enter inside the frame.
- Slowly release the crossbar so the locking plate inserts into the lip of the bed frame on the near side.

Rotate the barrel so that the tab is facing down thereby locking the crossbar into position.





 Place the second crossbrace on the bottom of the back rest panel of the frame. Repeat steps 2-6 to secure the crossbrace to the bed.



- Insert one bed rail into the barrels on one side of the bed, ensuring that the spring loaded knob is fully engaged.
- Insert the other bed rail into the barrels on the other side of the bed, ensuring that the spring loaded knob is fully engaged.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

LOWERING/RAISING THE RAIL

- Hold the rail, while pulling the spring loaded knobs.
- Lower or raise the rail to the desired height.
- Release the knobs and lower or raise the rail until the spring loaded knob "clicks" into position (unless the rail is at the lowest position).
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 for the opposite end of the bed rail.
