

Make Your Own Wind Chimes

Create and decorate beautiful butterfly and rainbow wind chimes.

Decorate

Decorate the wind chimes by adding translucent stickers. Try layering shapes to make different colors. Fill in all the clear spaces between the foil outlines.

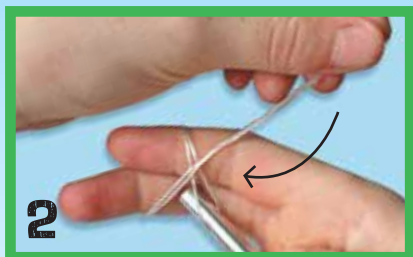
Younger children may need help tying the knots. Ask an adult to craft with you.

IMPORTANT: Follow all the knotting instructions to ensure knots stay tied.

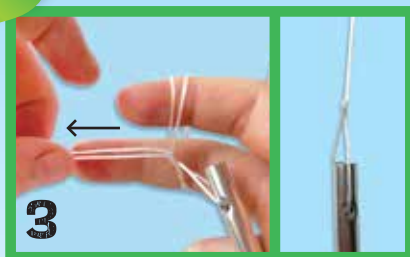
- Start by threading a pre-cut gel cord through one of the metal chimes.
- Match up the ends of the gel cord.

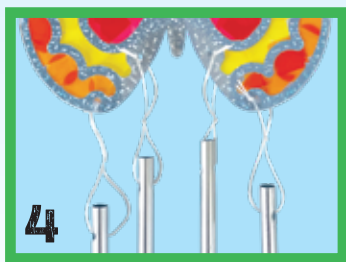
Tying the Knots



Wrap the cord around two fingers, creating an X where the cords cross.



Take the ends of the cord under the X and through the loop you have created. Pull tightly on the ends to secure the knot.



Adding Chimes

Tie on chimes using the knot instructions. Adjust the length of the cord so that the chimes will touch when the wind blows. Trim the ends. Repeat to tie on remaining chimes. **For extra security, add a dot of your own craft glue over the knots.**

Adding Beads

String a gel cord through the top hole. Even out the ends. String the beads over both strands. Repeat the knot at the top, creating a loop for hanging.



Display

Ask for help hanging your beautiful wind chimes. Hang them by an open window or under a covered porch. Then enjoy the chiming melody from a gentle breeze. *To keep your wind chimes looking great, display them in a protected area.*
