Hanging your door

Ask an adult for help and assistance with this step. You will need a small nail or screw – this will not harm the tree. You can also use a pencil to mark the position of your door.

- Select a tree. Position the fairy door you can use a pencil to mark the tree. This will help you decide where to place the nail or screw.
- Once the nail or screw is in place, use the hook on the back of the tree to hang your door. For extra security, or a permanent installation, an adult can drill inside and add extra screws or nails as needed.
- If you want to display your fairy door indoors, seek adult permission and assistance when hanging it.

Fairy Landscape Design

Decorate the entrance to your fairy door with the included flower, tulle butterfly, rock, mushrooms and gravel.

When you are finished, open your fairy door to see who is looking back at you!

Important Information about the Paint

Cover your work surface. Have a cup of water and paper towels handy.

Wear a smock or old clothes. This paint may stain clothing, fabric and other surfaces. Clean up any spills immediately while the paint is still wet.

Paint can settle and separate over time. Mix each color thoroughly before you begin painting.

Before changing colors, rinse and dry your brush thoroughly.



Before you begin

Although the paint is weather resistant, natural aging and weathering of your fairy door is expected. Many people find that as the fairy door weathers and ages, it adds charm and makes the door look like it is a part of nature. If you want to preserve the wood and painting, you can display your door indoors. Always seek adult permission and assistance before attaching your door to a tree.

Decide on a design for your door. Refer to the box for ideas or use your own creativity.

- Lay your contents on your work surface.
- Start by sliding the front door up and off the hinges. This will make it easier to paint.


Time to paint

Important note: Leave the inside of the door frame unpainted to prevent the door from sticking.

- Paint the door and the wooden accents and set them aside to dry.
- If you want to paint the other side of your door or accessories, make sure they are completely dry before flipping them over.
- Paint the rock and mushrooms and set them aside to dry.

Fun paint techniques to try

To make a flower use the end of your paint brush to create dots like this. Stripes and polka dots are fun and easy, too.



Welcome Fairies rock transfer

You can use the rock transfer directly on the bare rock, or over the painted rock. Make sure the paint is completely dry before proceeding with this step.

- Cut around the transfer design, trimming away the extra paper.
- Peel off the clear film and place the sticky side against your rock.
- Using a wet paper towel, lightly press the back of the transfer against the rock. Peel up the edge to make sure it is adhered. If not, use a bit more water. Do not move the transfer until it is adhered. Allow it to dry.







Assemble your door

- Use the glue provided to attach the wooden accents.
- Peel off the adhesive film from the mirror back and place it inside the door. Remove the protective film from the mirror.
- Slide the door on the hinges. Make sure the door can open and close freely.
- A mushroom can be used as a decorative door knob. Remove the plastic stick and cut off most of the mushroom stem. Use the glue to attach it to the latch. **NOTE: when opening and closing the door, use the wooden latch. If you pull on the mushroom it may come off the door.**
