#### **IMPORTANT**


- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the screws until each part is properly assembled.
- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.
- Keep Key Wrench in a safe place as the Bolts may need to be tightened up in the future.





Attach Top (F) to unit with Cam Locks, 1" Round Head Screws and Wooden Dowels.








Attach Mirror Supports (B) and (C) to Mirror Base (D) with 1" Round Head Screws.




# Assembly Instructions $6/\overline{11}$

### STEP 9

Attach Battens (E) to unit from Step 6 and unit from Step 8 with Bolts, Spring Washers and Flat Washers.

Tighten Bolts using Key Wrench. (See Figure 4)



### Assembly Instructions 7/11

#### **IMPORTANT**

• To help reduce the risk of the unit tipping over, the Tip-over Restraint must be installed following these instructions exactly.

#### **STEP 11**

Place the unit at desired location.

Mark wall with pencil to show position of hole in Back Panel (N). (See Figure 6)


Move unit.

Drill a 3/8" hole in wall 1" below mark.

Insert Anchor into the wall hole and attach Tip-over Restraint to Anchor with 1 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer. (See Figure 7)

Move unit back into place and insert Tip-over Restraint into unit through hole in Back Panel (N). (See Figure 8)

Attach Tip-over Restraint to unit with 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer. (See Figure 9)





1 1/2" Round Head Screw (M3x38) 1 pc.




1/2" Round Head Screw (M3x13) 1 pc. (+1 extra)










# Drawer (Q)





STEP 16


Attach Support (Q6) to Drawer Front (Q1) and Drawer Back (Q2).


1/4" Flat Head Screw Attach Drawer Side (Q3) to Drawer Front (Q1) and Drawer Back (Q2) with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

#### STEP 17

Insert Drawer Bottom (Q5) into the groove.

Attach Drawer Side (Q4) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.






#### STEP 18

Attach Handles with Machine Screws.

Note: Drawer assembly is not complete until 3/4" Flat Head Screws are used in a later step.







#### STEP 19

For Drawer (P) uninstall the lower center screw and loosen slighty the upper center screw.

For Drawer (Q) loosen slightly the two screws pre-installed on back of drawer front.








#### STEP 20


Insert drawers into unit, then adjust drawer front panels left or right and up or down until drawer gaps look proportional.



# STEP 21

Pull each drawer open slowly and re-tighten screws from Step 19. Make sure drawer front panels do not move and lock drawer front panels into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.


Note: These 3/4" Flat Head Screws must be installed to complete the drawer assembly.

Slide Drawers (P) and (Q) into position.
