DECORATING YOUR BOARDS



Peel the backer paper off the black grip sticker. Place it on the top of the board.



Add colored & metallic stickers to complete your designs. The stickers can also be used to cover any wrinkles or imperfections on your board skins.



Note: Stickers cannot be removed once placed on the skin.

Place stickers on the bottom of the board only. Stickers will not adhere to the grip tape.

Repeat the above steps until you have completed all 5 boards.

Save any glue, sticker or hydro-skins for touch up and repairs

When you are finished, add the wheels with your mini tool set, then get your fingers ready to catch some air as you practice your ollies, kick flips, heel flips and more.

Before you begin – you will need warm tap water, scissors, paper towels and a container that is at least $8" \times 5"$ (20.3 cm x 12.7cm) to dip your skateboards.

Depending on the age and ability of your child, younger crafters may need a little help along the way. If you make a mistake, extra skins are provided.




ACTIVATING YOUR HYDRO-SKINS






Select a design. Using your scissors, cut around the graphic.





Fill a container with enough water to submerge the board completely.





Peel the clear plastic sheet off the top of the Hydro-Skin and dip skin in water.

Do this quickly, keeping the white backer paper attached.






Remove skin from water. Center your skateboard over the skin, curved side down.


Please note the center hole on each end of the board. Once the boards are covered, you will be using only the center hole to attach the trucks.





With the board attached, place your skin back in the water. Use your finger to push the board to the bottom of your container.





Using your other hand, fold over each sides of the release paper, attaching the skin to the board. Repeat on all sides until the skin is adhered.

Peel off backer paper.





Remove the skateboard from the water. Use your sponge tool to press and smooth the skin. Set aside to dry.

PRO-TIP: You may need to push down firmly to remove any water or air bubbles.

ASSEMBLING YOUR BOARDS

Before you start assembling, note the different types of screws.



for attaching wheels to trucks








Use your screwdriver and small screws to attach the wheels to the trucks as shown.

If wheels don't spin, loosen screw until they turn easily.



Add a small dot of glue to the recessed areas on the bottom of the board.

Match the flat end of the truck to the recessed area and gently push.




Note: Truck semi-circles ← should "face" each other → when on the board





Use your screwdriver to locate and mark the center hole on each end of the board. This is where the long screw will go.

Push the screw into the center hole from the top of the board.



While holding the truck & board with one hand, use your screwdriver to attach the truck to the screw. Repeat on the other end of the board.
