


Turn super strong parachute cord into cool paracord wristbands. Complete set includes enough material to make 8 wristbands.


CREATING YOUR WRISTBAND

Unhook the buckle and insert it into the workstation on the side of your box as shown.







Cross the left cord (1) over the two center cords (2 and 3), creating a loop on the left side.




Place the right cord (4) over the left cord (1).




Pass the right cord (4) under the two center cords (2 and 3) and up through the loop you made on the left.



Tie the same knot starting on the right side. Cross the right cord (now 1) over the center cords (2 and 3) creating a loop on the right side.



Pull left and right cords (1 and 4) to tighten the knot.




Cross the left cord (now 4) over the right (1).

Pass the left cord (4) under the two center cords (2 and 3) and up through the loop you made on the right.




Pull the left and right cords (1 and 4) to tighten the knot.

Once the glue is dry, accent your buckle with a sticker.

To finish your wristband, secure the tails with a dot of glue and trim the

extra cord.



Follow the steps and continue making knots until you reach the buckle at the other end.
