

6 Safety



WARNING: SAFETY RIDING RULES

The user must follow all safety rules and guidelines, or serious injury or death may occur to the user.

- Always use common sense and safe practices when using the vehicle. The user must be at least 18 months old and weigh no more than 20 kg. This product is not suitable for children 4 years and older due to insufficient strength and size of the product.
- This product contains small parts that are for adult assembly only. Keep small children away • when assembling. Remove and dispose of all protective material and plastic bags before assembly.
- US Only: Riders must always wear a fitted helmet that complies with U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) Standard CFR 1203.
- Only sit on the seat in the vehicle.
- Do not allow more than one rider.
- Do not overload the vehicle. Do not remove the weight restriction decals.
- Do not pull the vehicle with another vehicle or similar device. ۲
- Keep body parts such as hands, legs, hair and clothing away from moving parts. Moving parts ۲ can cause serious injury.
- Always wear shoes in the vehicle. ۲
- Make sure that the child's feet rest in the footrests before pushing the car.
- Fasten seat belt properly before use.
- Do not operate near streets or motor vehicles. ٠
- Do not operate near drop-offs such as steps, steep inclines or hills. Operate on relatively level ۲ ground.
- Do not operate near water, swimming pools or other fluids. •
- Do not operate in dangerous weather conditions such as rain or snow. ۲
- Do not operate outside at night •
- Do not operate near loose dirt, mud, sand or fine gravel. •
- Do not operate near flammable vapours (gasoline, paint thinner, acetone, etc.). ۲
- Always use the vehicle in a safe, secure environment with adult supervision. •
- Periodically check hardware and tighten if necessary. Replace worn or broken parts immediately.
- **RISK OF FIRE.** Do not bypass.



WARNING: BATTERY SAFETY

• Tampering with or modifying the electric circuit system may cause shock, fire or explosion. It could permanently damage the system. Keep the charger housing closed to prevent exposed wiring, which may cause electric shock.




- When replacing AAA batteries, always replace both batteries at the same time. Do not mix old batteries with new batteries or batteries of different types.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Only use the batteries specificed by the manufacturer.
- Non-rechargable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Rechargable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturer's instruction.
- Weak or exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminal.
- Remove batteries if product is to be left unused for a long time.

WARNING: ADULT SUPERVISION REQUIRED

- Before using the vehicle, the rider must understand the vehicle controls and safety issues.
- It is the responsibility of the adult to educate the child and to determine if the child is capable of understanding the vehicle controls.
- An adult must ALWAYS directly supervise the use of this vehicle.
- NEVER leave a child unsupervised in the vehicle.



Assemble the Wheels 9




Front Wheels

- 1. To assemble the front wheels, place a washer on the front axle.
- 2. Slide the wheel onto the axle, ensuring that the holes for the rim are facing out.
- 3. Slide another washer onto the axle, then insert the snap-pin into the hole on the axle to secure the wheel in place.
- 4. Snap the rim onto the wheel. Repeat the above steps for the opposite wheel.

Rear Wheels


- 1. To assemble the rear wheels, place a washer on the rear axle.
- 2. Slide the rear wheel orientation sleeve onto the rear axle.
- 3. Slide a washer onto the axle.
- 4. Slide the rear wheel into the axle, ensuring that the holes for the rim are facing out.
- 5. Slide on another washer, then insert the snap-pin into the hole on the axle to secure the wheel in place. Repeat for the opposite wheel.

10 Steering Wheel/Windshield Assembly



Assemble the Steering Wheel


- 1. Remove the steering wheel screw and steering wheel nut from the steering wheel.
- 2. Slide the steering wheel onto the steering rod.
- 3. Align the holes of the steering wheel with the holes on the rod.
- Insert the screw into the holes on the steering wheel and steering rod. Then insert the nut on the other side to attach the steering wheel and the steering rod.
- 5. Tighten with a Phillips screwdriver (not included) .



Assemble the Windshield


- 1. Align the slots of the windshield and the dash board.
- 2. Push the top of the windshield until it clicks into place to complete the assembly.

Mirror/ Seat/Push Bar Assembly 11




Side Mirror Assembly

- 1. Insert the mirror into the slot on the side of the body.
- Push it into the slot until you hear a click to complete the assembly. Repeat on the other side.



Assemble the Seat


- 1. Align the buckles of the seat with the slots on the car body.
- 2. Press the seat until you hear the click to complete the assembly.





Assemble the Push Bar


- 1. Press the push bar into the slot at the rear end of the body.
- 2. Make sure that the round hole of the fixed part faces toward the back, and the square hole toward the front.
- 3. Align the hole of the fixed part with the hole of the end of the push bar. Fit it with the screw and tighten with a screwdriver to secure.

12 Batteries and Operating Instructions









Insert Batteries

 Open the battery cover using a Phillips screwdriver (not included). Insert 2 AAA batteries with the correct polarity, then resecure the cover using a screwdriver.

To Operate:

- 1. Press buttons on steering wheel to hear horn and engine sounds.
- 2. Turn wheels right or left with the steering wheel.
- 3. Rotate the key to hear a play clicking sound.
- 4. Speed pointer can be moved.

Storable footrest

- 1. Pull up the release clip inside the push car
- 2. Then slide the footrest backward to allow child to use his/her feet to move the car.

Adjustable handle bar

 Push the button on top of the handlebar to adjust the height of the bar.

- Regularly inspect all vehicle parts to ensure they are in good working condition.
- Remove any damaged parts and immediately contact Customer Service for replacement parts. See Service and Repairs on Page 24 for more information.
- DO NOT operate the vehicle if there are any damaged parts.
- Carefully clean the vehicle with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not get water in or near any electrical parts. Do not wash the vehicle with a hose.
- Store the vehicle indoors or use a tarp to cover it. Keep away from stoves, heaters, or other sources of heat.
