#### MAINTENANCE

It may be necessary to periodically wipe down the heater and reflector, depending on the placement and the amount of use.

#### How to clean the reflector:

- 1. Disconnect the power cord from the outlet. Be sure heater has completely cooled.
- 2. Remove the safety bars by pressing down on the top edge and gently pulling forward until it releases.
- 3. Wipe the reflector with a dry soft cloth or one treated with detergent.

## **INSTALLATION ON THE WALL OR CEILING**

There are four brackets and fasteners to use with the heater. There are also 4 square fastener washers (0.98 in.) in the slot on the back side of the heater. **STEP 1:** 

Position the square bolts inside the slot (Figure 1) with 2 of the brackets as shown in Figure 2. Be sure the distance between the brackets matches the distance they will be spaced on the wall. Fasten using 4 short screws. A minimum of 16 inches is suggested.

## **INSTALLATION ON THE WALL OR CEILING**

#### STEP 2:

The other 2 brackets are fastened by using the 4 long screws and their matching plastic accessories at the appropriate distance on the wall parallel to the floor (At least 2 yd. from the floor and at least 0.5 yd. from the ceiling) (Figure 3).

### STEP 3:

Join the brackets on the heater with the brackets fastened on the wall using 2 bolts and their matching washers and wing nuts (Figure 4). Install the heater at the proper angle (in the direction of the area to be heated).

**NOTES:** Angle of heater can be adjusted by partially loosening the wingnuts, adjusting the heater angle, then retightening. Be sure the tabs interlock with the holes in the brackets.

Electric wiring for the heater has to be done by a qualified specialist if needed.

## WARNING! DO NOT DIRECT HEATER AT THE CEILING, WALL OR OTHER NEARBY SURFACE OR OBJECT.
