AWARNING

Drowning Hazard: Babies have **drowned** while using infant bath tubs and bath slings. **To prevent drowning:**

- Stay in arm's reach of your baby.
- Never rely on a toddler or preschooler to help your baby or alert you to trouble. Babies have drowned even with other children in or near bath tub.
- Babies can drown in as little as 1 inch of water. Use <u>as little water as possible</u> to bathe your baby.
- Use in **empty** adult tub or sink.
- Keep drain open in adult tub or sink.
- NEVER bathe baby until you have tested the water temperature. ALWAYS check water temperature before placing child into tub.
- Bath water should be between 90°F and 100°F (32.2°C and 37.8°C).
- Bath sling suitable for babies from birth (0-3 months, up to 10 lbs.).
- This product is not a toy. DO NOT allow children to play with it.
- **Fall Hazard:** Babies have suffered **head injuries** falling from infant bath tubs and bath slings. **To prevent falls:**
- Place tub only in adult tub or sink for safe use.
- Never lift or carry baby in tub and/or bath sling.
- Never use on uneven or elevated surfaces.
- NEVER leave children unattended.
- Discontinue use of product if damaged, broken, or disassembled.

YOUR TUB'S FEATURES



NEWBORN MODE: SETTING UP THE BATH SLING

NEWBORN BATH SLING IN INFANT TUB

NOTE: Never place more than 1 inch of water in tub. Always keep the drain open in the adult bath tub.

1. Remove sling from plastic bag. Securely fasten the 4 clips onto the baby bath tub (**Figure A**). There are special slots for the 4 clips molded on the baby bath tub (**Figure B**).

- 2. Place the baby bath tub into a full sized adult bath tub or on a flat surface.
- 3. Place newborn carefully onto bath sling to bathe.

Always check water temperature prior to bathing child. Bath water temperature should never exceed 100° F (37.8° C). **NEVER** leave child unattended while in bath.





INFANT MODE: SETTING UP THE TUB IN A SINK

Note: We recommend Newborn Mode (Figure C) for ages 0-6 weeks and Infant Mode (Figure D) for ages 6 weeks to 3 months (or when child can sit up unassisted).

TO POSITION TUB IN SINK

Single Sink: Place notch of toddler side of tub on one side of sink edge and outer rim of newborn side of tub on the other side. Double Sink: Place legs of newborn side of tub over sink divider and place the notch of the toddler side of tub on sink edge.

- **1.** Shift tub to one side as far as it will go and push down firmly to confirm tub stability.
- **2.** Shift tub in opposite direction as far as it will go and push down firmly to reconfirm tub stability.

CAUTION: Always test for secure fit in sink before placing baby in tub.

TODDLER MODE

1. Position Toddler Tub in a full-size bathroom tub or on a flat surface where you are bathing your child.

Always check water temperature prior to bathing child. Bath water temperature should be between 90°F (32.2° C) and 100° F (37.8° C). Always keep the drain open in the adult tub.

2. Place child carefully in Toddler Tub to bathe. (Figure E).

Fill the tub with 1 inch or less of water. **Note:** Never fill past the Max Water Level Line marked inside the tub (**Figure F**).
