RESULTS

The study population consisted of 100 participants, with a mean age of 55.0 years (SD = 15.0). The majority of participants were female (50.0%), and the majority were White (30.0%). The majority of participants had a high school or less education level (30.0%), and the majority had an annual income of less than \$10,000 (15.0%). The majority of participants were married (30.0%).

The study population was divided into two groups based on age: young adults (18-24 years) and older adults (25-104 years). The young adults group consisted of 15 participants, and the older adults group consisted of 85 participants. The mean age of the young adults group was 21.0 years (SD = 3.0), and the mean age of the older adults group was 64.0 years (SD = 18.0).

The study population was also divided into two groups based on gender: male and female. The male group consisted of 50 participants, and the female group consisted of 50 participants. The mean age of the male group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0), and the mean age of the female group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0).

The study population was also divided into two groups based on ethnicity: White and non-White. The White group consisted of 30 participants, and the non-White group consisted of 70 participants. The mean age of the White group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0), and the mean age of the non-White group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0).

The study population was also divided into two groups based on education level: high school or less and more than high school. The high school or less group consisted of 30 participants, and the more than high school group consisted of 70 participants. The mean age of the high school or less group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0), and the mean age of the more than high school group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0).

The study population was also divided into two groups based on income: less than \$10,000 and more than \$10,000. The less than \$10,000 group consisted of 15 participants, and the more than \$10,000 group consisted of 85 participants. The mean age of the less than \$10,000 group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0), and the mean age of the more than \$10,000 group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0).

The study population was also divided into two groups based on marital status: married and non-married. The married group consisted of 30 participants, and the non-married group consisted of 70 participants. The mean age of the married group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0), and the mean age of the non-married group was 55.0 years (SD = 15.0).
