OPERATION

1. Remove existing radiator cap.

AWARNING: Never remove radiator cap when engine is hot.

Identify and install proper adapter and cap on to the radiator or expansion tank opening.

Note: Be sure the gasket is in place for a proper seal.

- Fit the funnel snugly into adapter opening. If an angled adapter or extension is needed, it must be installed prior to installing the funnel.
- Slowly pour coolant (see owner's manual for type of coolant), into the funnel allowing air to escape. Fill the funnel about 1/3 and start the engine. Idle until engine warms to open thermostat completely.

AWARNING: Excessive RPM can cause fluid to overflow the funnel. If this happens shut off the engine, wait for the fluid level to drop back down before restarting engine, wait for the fluid to stabilize.

- Add coolant until the system is full. If you still have any fluid left in the funnel shut off the engine. Reach in and squeeze the upper radiator hose, use caution it may be hot.
- 6. With your other hand press the funnel stopper into the hole at the base of the funnel. Release the hose and it will pull any residual coolant between the base of the funnel and the radiator cap. This should provide a spill proof removal of the funnel and cap.







7. Remove the adapters and replace original factory radiator cap.
