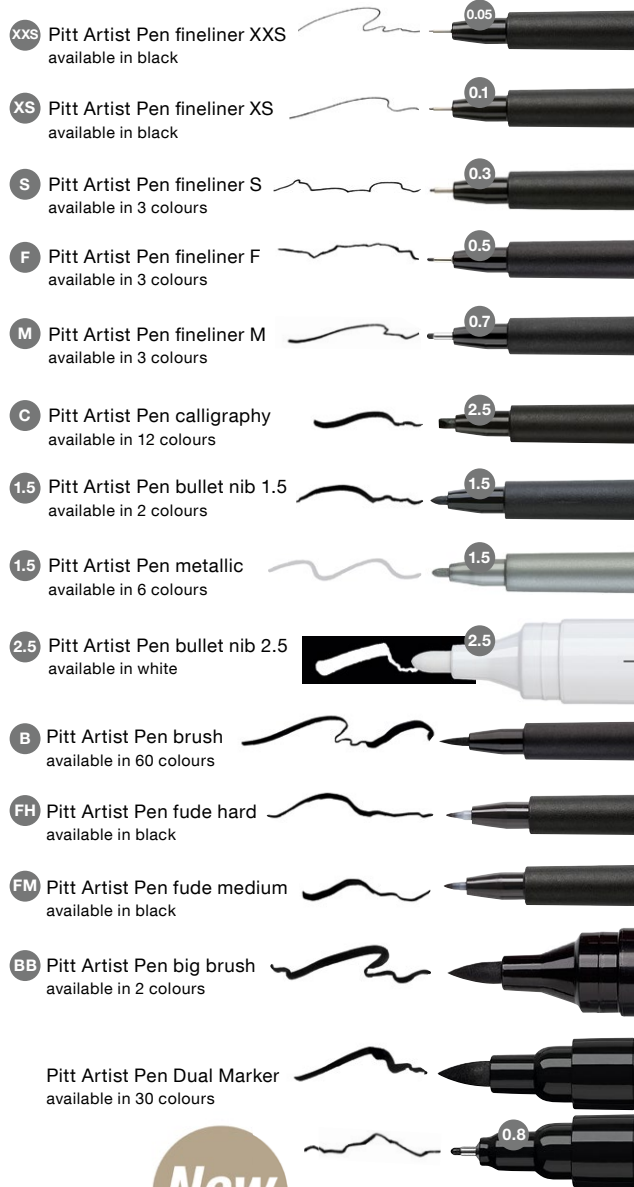

Whether fine hatching, precise accents or quick sketches – fineliners are the ideal counterpart to the colourful Pitt Artist Pens with brush nib. The different line widths, from filigree to striking, can be creatively combined with other drawing media and are therefore ideal for current creative trends, such as urban sketching and watercolouring.

Due to their high opacity, the white Pitt Artist Pens look particularly good on coloured and dark paper, either as an undercoat for coloured Pitt Artist Pens or as an individual drawing. The white ink pens are also perfect for adding highlights to watercolour paintings.

Pitt Artist Pen fude

The short fude nib of the new Pitt Artist Pens is ideal for starting to write and draw with a flexible brush nib. The softer “medium” nib is best used for larger lettering, the “hard” nib is better suited for smaller, finer lettering. Both fude pens are great for handlettering, sketchnotes and bullet journaling.
