Incense Smoker Set schoolhouse

The Räuchermann and Räucherfrau (or "smoking man" and "smoking woman") were born out of the rural German tradition in which incense is burned to bless the home and bring good luck. Representing the folk life of the early 19th century, these charming characters are lovingly made by hand in the Erzgebirge region of Germany. The family-owned company which produces them has been crafting the finest wooden ornaments and collectibles for more than 150 years.

THE INCENSE

Natural, aromatic ingredients like exotic tree resins, rare roots and barks, fragrant blossoms and flavorful spices are freshly ground and carefully dried to give these high-quality incense cones their traditional fragrance.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The Incense Smoker comes in two pieces. Detach the bottom of the smoker and place the incense cone inside on the metal plate.
- 2. Light the incense cone on the tip until glowing, return the smoker top and allow the incense to smoke. Incense smoke will flow from the smoker's mouth.
- 3. The smoker should be placed on a level, secure surface, making sure that the incense cone stays in the upright position.

CAUTION: VERY HOT! THE SMOKER IS NOT A TOY. IT SHOULD NEVER BE USED WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION OR LEFT UNATTENDED WHILE BURNING. WHILE THE INSIDE OF THE SMOKER IS SAFE FROM THE HEAT OF THE CONE, SHOULD A LIGHTED INCENSE CONE COME INT O CONTACTWITH UNPROTECTED SURFACES, IT MAY CAUSE CHARRING OR START A FIRE. INCENSE CONES ARE NOT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION.
