

2017 DUNDEE HILLS AVA PINOT NOIR



Rose petal, red raspberry and faint hints of cedar mix with brown sugar and toasted cocoa to create a sweet and savory aroma. A fresh, red fruited entry followed by white pepper and dusty tannins create a sweet textured wine with a lingering finish.
